Love Liberated, a Sacramento-based collective, is dedicated to fostering radical pleasure and sexual liberation within the BIQTPOC community. We are looking to build a Board of Directors committed to addressing the diverse needs of LGBTQ+ people of color across all demographics. We're seeking candidates with an understanding of gender identity, critical race theory, sexual health, and leadership experience or equivalent qualifications. Organizational skills, multitasking abilities, and the ability to work alone and with a team, along with attention to detail, are valued in potential board members. This commitment will equal around 2-4 hours a week depending on the season.

Our Vision To establish spaces that facilitate and uphold collective sexual liberation for BIQTPOC.

Our Mission is to foster sexual liberation for BIQTPOC by means of Comprehensive Education, Creativity, and Healing.

In this role, we're looking for a board member that will help shape our comprehensive funding strategy, research and identify new fundraising opportunities, and cultivate relationships with potential funders. You'll work closely with our board members to craft this plan, prioritizing the sustainability of our organization to support the work that we do within our community.

We encourage everyone, highlighting Black and Brown, TGI, disabled, former foster youth and formerly incarcerated individuals, to apply without hesitation. Love Liberated values diverse backgrounds and experiences, recognizing that unique perspectives enrich our collective mission.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be local to Sacramento, CA
- Must be a strong accomplice or individual with lived experience of this community
- Act as an authentic ambassador of the organization
- Actively commit to a 2-year term on the board
- Commit to raise a minimum of \$150.00 “give or get” each year with the support of the development staff
- Connect the organization to networks and resources.
- Attend at least 6 board meetings a year and one half-day board retreat
- Attend and support at least 2 fundraising meetings a month

- Attend and participate in our annual fundraising event
- Ability to find and screen eligible grants that are in alignment with our work

- Proven track record in fundraising and strategy development
- Strong time management skills and ability to meet due dates
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills
- Proficient in Google Drive and managing spreadsheets

- Comfortable and intentional connecting with people across all economic backgrounds, from grassroots community members to major donors
