

**VOLUNTEER AND MEMBER
Standards of Conduct Agreement
VOTER CHOICE NJ**

The mission of VOTER CHOICE NJ is to educate the public about and promote electoral reforms that increase the accessibility and range of choice on the ballot in order to produce fairer and more democratic outcomes. Voter Choice New Jersey advocates for the expanded use of Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) in all elections, which allows voters to rank the candidates on the ballot in order of preference. RCV would make New Jersey elections more competitive, inclusive and fair by encouraging the participation of more candidates, parties and voters and by ensuring outcomes that more accurately reflect the majority of the voters.

VOTER CHOICE NJ is building a movement that is transparent, diverse and inclusive at all levels of our operation. To facilitate communication among ourselves and encourage participation of all people who indicate an interest in RCV, all members (regardless of leadership or team status) and volunteers (regardless of whether involvement is singular, occasional or continuous) must read the organization's Standards of Conduct, and agree to abide by such standards.

Standards of Conduct: As a member or volunteer in VOTER CHOICE NJ, you must:

1. Not engage in criminal, dishonest, notoriously disgraceful, racially or sexually/gender biased discriminatory conduct, or any other conduct deemed to have a negative effect on VOTER CHOICE NJ and all its participants.
2. Treat all members and volunteers and potential supporters in a professional, courteous, and respectful manner.
3. Must protect the confidentiality of the identifying information of all members, volunteers, supporters and all those who contribute to the advancement of the organization's mission.
4. Not knowingly misrepresent the mission, goals and objectives of VOTER CHOICE NJ.
5. Not solicit business from the public while engaged in VOTER CHOICE NJ activity or use the knowledge and information you gain about members, volunteers, supporters, or contributors for any direct or indirect personal benefit for yourself or any other specific individual.
6. At all times, act in good faith when editing VOTER CHOICE NJ documents, sharing and distributing VOTER CHOICE NJ materials, and communicating with others about the organization.

Failure to comply with these standards could result in, but is not limited to, the following: denial of access to Google Drive documents, and exclusion from participation in the organization at any level, including teams, meetings and events.
