Longmeadow High School will administer the digital PSAT/NMSQT (Practice SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) to juniors on Wednesday October 25, 2023. The digital PSAT is a practice test for the new digital SAT. The digital SAT will be offered beginning March, 2024.

The following important information should assist you in registering for the PSAT and preparing for the test.

- The fee for the PSAT is an \$18.00 check payable to Longmeadow High School.
 Students should bring their registration form and payment to the School Counseling Office before or after school or during lunch.
- Fee waivers are available for students who qualify. See your counselor or Mr. Rosemond for more information
- Once you register, you will receive detailed information about the testing format, and test preparation.
- On the day of testing, arrive to your assigned testing room by 7:48 with your Chromebook, pencil or pen, and school ID
- Your Chromebook must be fully charged the morning of testing.
- Students will not have access to charging during testing.
- Testing will start promptly at 8:00 a.m.
- Testing will end by 11:15 a.m. Test takers will go to either second or third lunch depending on their G3 class.
- The testing app Bluebook has a built-in graphing calculator, but you are allowed to bring your own approved scientific or graphing calculator to the test.

Students must register for the PSAT by Friday October 6th at 3:00 p.m. Due to the the registration process for digital testing, no late registrations can be accepted.

The following important information should assist you in preparing for the PSAT.

- Room assignments will be emailed to students and posted outside the main office a day before the test date.
- On the day of testing, arrive to your assigned testing room by 7:48 with your Chromebook, pencil or pen, and school ID
- Your Chromebook must be fully charged the morning of testing.
- Students will not have access to charging during testing.
- Testing will start promptly at 8:00 a.m.
- Testing will end by 11:15 a.m. Test takers will go to either second or third lunch depending on their G3 class.
- Testing will be administered through Bluebook, a College Board sponsored testing app.
- Bluebook will be preloaded on your school assigned Chromebook.
- The testing app Bluebook has a built-in graphing calculator, but you are allowed to bring your own approved scientific or graphing calculator to the test.
- Students will be provided scratch paper to take notes, solve problems, etc.
