

### Cosmic Week-7/31 to 8/13

*To represent the innovativeness in cosmic magic, the ingredients for the cosmic dust are metal and gears from Tinker Toss. This dust can be used in Cottonpuff Field for animated home decoration items!*

### Sun and Moon Week-8/14 to 27

*The sun and moon dusts are unique as they require very rare materials.*

*The last light of day needed for the sun dust can be collected in Sunflower Gully if five fairies use the sun emote at the same time. The sun dust can be added to the light bead bracelet (tailored at Mendy's) to add a bit of magic to it. It'll give you a magical pixie dust trail that will appear if you wear it! The trail will depend on the color you make the bracelet:*

*For the mermaid's voice which is used in the moon dust, you'll need to go to Mermaid Grotto (which is open for the event). Five fairies will need to use the singing emote at the same time. The dust can be added to the shell anklet (can also be tailored at Mendy's) to create an aura for your fairy. The color and motion of the aura will depend on the color of the anklet.*

### Fun Facts about the OG Pixie Hollow

- *While Pixie Hollow officially launched in October 2008, it was actually around since January 2007. Back then, all you'd do is create a fairy, decorate her house and change her outfit. This version remained in international versions of Pixie Hollow.*
- *Some fairies had the address, "Havendish Place" on their profile. This meant that they were likely a Pixie Hollow staff member, with some being created as early as January 2007 before the fairy creation even launched to the public. These fairies include Sprinkles Sugarblossom, Stella Mangoflower and Stella Fluttershimmer. They can frequently be seen in Pixie Hollow's event blog snapshots.*
- *Fairies that played during the beta received a Founding Fairy badge and an acorn necklace. The acorn necklace may be a reference to the "kiss" necklace Peter gave Wendy in the original Peter Pan book.*
- *Never Council member Sweet Pea's necklace has a hidden Mickey on it. Mickey shaped bushes can also be seen on the Fly Up map.*
  - *The Ice Palace and Mermaid Grotto can be seen from the map*
- *The Pixie Post Office is located inside JM Berrie's mailbox. The numbers on that mailbox are 122704 which means December 27 1904 when the Peter Pan play first appeared on the London stage*
- *During the Pixie Hollow Farewell event, there were some Queen's Boutique gowns that were new. What's interesting is that some of them were fall or Halloween related. It could be a sign that the Pixie Hollow team was planning on the game to stay open a bit longer but I guess the higher-ups wanted it to shut down.*
- *Camp Pixie Dust 2013 (the last event) was supposed to have been divided into five two-week sections, but the second to last section, Pixie Party Weeks, which was in August, surprisingly only lasted for one week. Immediately after this week ended and the Sparkler began, the closure was announced. My guess is that the Pixie Hollow team planned the closure in late July or something before the August event calendar came out.*
