Getting Started (Individual First – Then Create and Work With a Learning Team)

1. Go to g.co/applieddigitalskills
2. Click "Sign In," and sign in with their School Google account.
3. If asked select "I am a learner".
4. If asked click yes when asked if you are taking this course with an instructor.
5. If you have not already joined our class, then enter class code connected to your period.

6. Click on the “Activities” menu and choose “Create a Presentation “All About a Topic”

Human Diseases - Module 56

- Identify the different types of human diseases.
- Understand the risk factors for human chronic diseases.
- Discuss the historically important human diseases.
- Identify the major emergent infectious diseases.
- Discuss future challenges for improving human health.

Toxicology and Chemical Risks - Module 57

- Identify the major types of harmful chemicals.
- Explain how scientists determine the concentrations of chemicals that harm organisms.

Risk Analysis - Module 58

- Explain the processes of qualitative versus quantitative risk assessment.
- Understand how to determine the amount of risk that can be tolerated.
- Discuss how risk management balance potential harm against other factors.
- Contrast the innocent-until-proven-guilty principle and the precautionary principle.

<div><div></div><div>Add Video</div><div>Import and embed a video clip into your Slides presentation.</div><div>→</div></div>	<div><div></div><div>Publish to the Web</div><div>Publish your animated story to the Web to share with a wider audience.</div><div>→</div></div>
