Facility Safety Protocol

Memorial Pool & Health Club

When families arrive at the facility, they can park in the main parking lot but are reminded to practice social distancing. At this time, no spectators will be allowed in the building.

- All swimmers and their families must be familiar with the [LSC COVID Safety Plan](#) accessible on the LSC website.
- Swimmers will be required to arrive at Memorial in an agreed upon 15-minute window.
- Swimmers will enter the facility at the main door located on the south-east corner of the building.
- They will proceed directly down the stairs, through the family change room and directly onto the deck.
- Athletes and staff must stagger entry and proceed directly to the pool deck. Shoes will be removed before entering the pool deck.
- A city staff member will do a health screening and Proof of Vaccination and ID check before escorting athletes into the facility.
 - As of January 4, 2022, the enhanced vaccine certificate with the **official QR Code is required to access** the facility under the Province's Proof of Vaccination Policy.
 - Medical exemptions are now integrated into electronic certificates with QR codes and medical notes are no longer acceptable.
 - Vaccine Receipts without a QR code will no longer be accepted.
 - Please ensure swimmers are using the government of Canada app, all other apps will not be accepted as the facility will not be able to scan and read the information.
- Attendance will be taken by LSC.
- **Swimmers will wear masks** as they enter the facility and if they are required to wait outside, they will practice social distancing.
- Change rooms are available, with a maximum capacity of 4 per change room (including the family change room).
- Swim bags will be left at the designated area of the deck 2m apart.
- Once bags are deposited, and swimmers are ready they can proceed to their pre-designated lanes.
- During training, athletes must maintain all social distancing protocols.
- Athletes will have a scheduled 15-minute window to check-out and depart the facility – there will be no access to any other areas of the facility and socializing will not be permitted.
- Athletes must wear a face covering as they depart the facility.
- Athletes exit through the change rooms, up the stairs and out the main door of the facility.
- Swimmers will proceed directly to their vehicles, there will be no socializing.
