

(Grade. 3) Dance—Ballet & Contemporary (All gender)

Dance 3 introduces students to the expressive elements of classical ballet and contemporary dance. Students study primary Vaganova Ballet Technique along with basic Graham and Horton techniques. Barre and center combinations become more complex, with a focus on épaulement, arm and head placement, and consistent turnout. Musicality and expression are emphasized to support dual training in both styles. This year-long performance class includes recitals in the Winter and Spring Elementary Arts Festivals.

This year-long class includes performances in the Winter Wonderland Concert on Dec. 13, the Spring Elementary Arts Festival Concert on May 15, as well as chapel performances throughout the year.
