

Roles and Responsibilities

Signage Team

This person is responsible for ensuring that all signage is put up according to the risk assessment before the race and ensuring that it is all removed after the event. They would likely need to turn up early. This will be split into a team for putting up signs and a team for removing.

Sign on

This person is responsible for checking licences, ensuring that everyone signs on and collects the correct number.

Lead Marshal

This person is responsible for organising the marshals. They will be expected to understand the locations that all the marshals are being sent to and be prepared to answer any questions from the marshals.

Accredited Marshal

This person is an AMS as assigned on the risk assessment. They Must have completed the British Cycling AM course for this role

Red Flag Marshal

This person is a red flag marshal as assigned on the risk assessment.

Judging

This person is responsible for writing down any dropped riders each lap, as well as judging the final. They will be assisted by chip-timing.

Driver

Drivers will be responsible for driving the lead cars as well as the comms cars. They Must be normally insured on their vehicle, have a Race Bronze membership or higher, be 21 or over and their vehicle cannot exceed 1.66m
