

## Dear BDCHS Families,

During the 2025-2026 school year, SLA Management will continue to provide nutrition services for our students. While considering the increasing food costs nationally, we feel it is of utmost importance to be able to provide reasonably priced, nutritious meals. Our students will be able to receive a complete meal for an average cost of \$7.50. A wide variety of a la carte options are also available daily. Meals are prepared onsite, by our SLA team. We have the capability to serve hot meals and can offer a variety of options daily. This also means no pre-ordering! Students will just need money on their lunch account and enter their student ID number to charge their items. Students who choose to bring their own food from home will still be able to have access to microwaves in the cafeteria.

## Some important details are as follows:

- ALL students must create a new account as we now will be utilizing LunchTime (School Payment Portal) for payments. Click the link: <u>School Payment Portal Powered By</u> <u>LunchTime Software</u> or go to our Family Portal, which has a Student Nutrition section. LunchTime also has an app!
- If your student qualifies for a free lunch provided by BDCHS, you will be able to complete an electronic application, which will be available on our Family Portal under the Student Nutrition section once the school year begins.
- Lunch menus are posted in the cafeteria, in addition to important nutritional and dietary restriction information can be found on Nutrislice daily. Nutrislice is an interactive menu which can be accessed from the school website: Family Portal>SLA Cafe Menu and click on Brooks DeBartolo Collegiate High School.
- Sign up for the SLA Cafe Newsletter located to the right of the monthly menu! You can even get the Nutrislice App to easily view the monthly menu from your phone.
