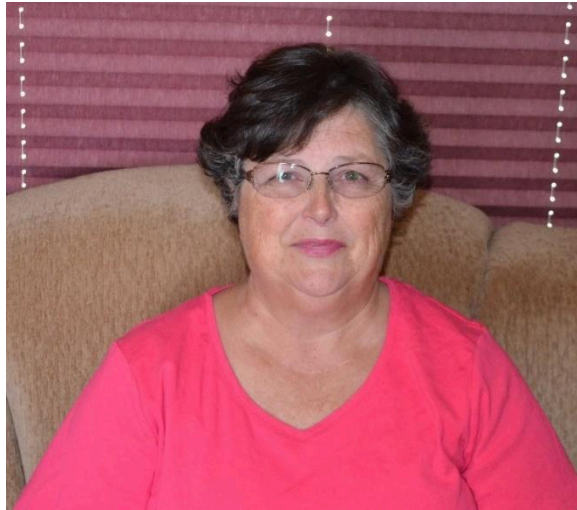




Ann Louise Vibbert

Ann Louise Vibbert, the Life Partner of Dallas Vibbert for 54+ years died Sunday September 27, 2020. She was battling lymphoma cancer and developed a massive infection. Ann was in hospice for several days before being called home. She was without pain and was made comfortable all the way to the end.

Ann was born at home in Orangevale, CA the 30th of November 1946. She is survived by husband Dallas, her older siblings, Hervey, Mary, and Bob. Ann has many nephews and nieces.

Ann and Dallas were married the 2nd of April 1966. Ann had three children: Barbara, David, and Matthew. All were present during her final days.

Due to Dallas's Military and Corporate involvement Ann & Dallas moved 21 times during the first 21 years of marriage. They moved around the block and around the world. Ann endured 2 years in northern Japan, 2 years at Fort Riley, KS, 3 years in Iowa, 3 1/2 years in Germany, 2 tours at Fort Huachuca, AZ, and 3 years at Fort McPherson, GA. Finally, they both ended up living 33 years in Plano, Texas. Dallas and Ann moved to Princeton, Texas in 2019.

Ann taught reading and organized and led a preschool program in Atlanta. At age 52 she gained a teaching certificate in reading and ESL. Ann worked many charity jobs, always seeking to make life better for all. Ann was a wonderful friend and rescuer of animals.

A family only memorial was held on the 29th of September. A more formal memorial will be conducted when restrictions are lifted. Her ashes will be interred at the National Cemetery near Arlington, TX.
