Diocese MJD jointly with Caritas MJD/Canossian/Church Of St. Philip Segamat.

BOARD OF MANAGEMENT

Headed by PP of St.Philp Segamat

And members appointed by Caritas/, Cannosians and endorsed by Bishop MJD.

SCOPE/OBJECTIVE

To provide accommodation, accompaniment and Pastoral Care for the Students by setting up Hostel using the current vacant Convent building at Segamat.

Accommodation for School going Children Age between 15 to 17 years old.(Girls Only)

Reaching out to marginalised/B40 and those in need.

The Scrutiny and Identification process of borders will be undertaken by the Board of Management and Principal of the Secondary School.

Parents and Guardians will be briefed and will take responsibility jointly with the BOM.

Documents to be prepared by BOM and vetted by Diocese MJD/Caritas/Cannosian as stakeholders.

Parents and Guardians will endorse as acceptance to the Terms and Conditions governing the Hostel and Children as Stipulated by the BOM and other stakeholders.

DAILY OPERATIONS OF HOSTEL

The Management team will be responsible for the operations and day to day running of the Hostel.

Security of the Children and Premises will also be overseen by the BOM, with the assistance of Permanently employed and/or Voluntary staff if the need arises.

Two Canossian Sisters will be permanently staying to oversee and look after the Borders. A stipend to be paid ,amount to be agreed and considered by the stakeholders.

A Warden to be employed on a full time basis to ensure Discipline of Borders and that they adhere to the Rules and Regulations of the Hostel drawn out by the Board and Management Team.

A Security Guard will be at the Hostel Premises from 6pm to 7am daily.(Existing Convent Guard).

A Part time cook to prepare daily meals.

Breakfast, Lunch, Tea, Dinner.

All Boarders will take ownership and responsibility for their well being, safety and cleanliness.

They will also undertake to ensure the Dormitories, Pantry ,Toilets and surrounding area is kept clean.

TUITION

Tuition class for will be arranged if needed.

HOME VISIT

Boarders are allowed home visits fortnightly. To spend the weekend with their respective families.

PREPARATION/REPAIR/RENOVATION/REFURBISHMENT OF THE CONVENT BUILDING

- 1. Toilets need to repaired and renovated.
- 2. Pantry and Laundry area need to repaired/renovated.
- 3.Dormitories/Rooms need to be renovated and furnished.
- 4. Sister's Rooms to be repaired and furnished.
- 5. Purchase of Beds, Cupboards, Mattress, Pillows.
- 6. Washing Machine, Refrigerator, Heater and Cutleries.
- 7. Wiring, Piping and Painting works to be done.
- 8. Study tables and Chairs to be purchased.
- 9. Other areas that need attention not mentioned above.

QUOTATIONS

Local contractors to be appointed to undertake and complete all the above and other works within the stipulated time frame decided by Diocese /Caritas MJD.

All Quotations to be vetted by Board accordingly and as per work specification and submitted to Caritas for Approval prior to commencement of work and installation of furniture and fittings.

FUNDING

To be undertaken and provided by Caritas for all the initial works, setting up ,renovations ,repair, refurbishment, installation of piping, wiring painting and all other electrical appliances and other needs not mentioned.

Canossian Sisters to assist in this funding where possible.

BOARD OF MANAGEMENT HEADED BY PARISH PRIEST OF ST PHILIP SEGAMAT.

Will be responsible for the day to day running and expenses.

It will be jointly undertaken by Diocese/Caritas/Canossians and St.Philip, Segamat POHD and SSVP.

Initial Operating Fund to be set up by Caritas.

OTHER MATTERS

All other decision to be made by Parish Priest of St Philip, Segamat, BOM in consultation with Canossian and Caritas.

And to be endorsed and approved by Bishop of MJD.
