Question	Response
Is there a place where we can give suggestions for Gemini Updates? When using Gemini Canvas, it generates complex math equations, but when you export or copy to Google docs, the symbols don't keep its math type formatting. There's not an option to download as PDF from Gemini Canvas either. Only solution I have found is to screenshot from Gemini Canvas creation itself.	Thanks for identifying that issue! I (Eric) have passed this along to the Gemini team. In the meantime, the only workaround I have found is to select all of the content in the Canvas window, then press Ctrl and P to open the standard print dialog window, then go to the advanced settings and choose to only print the selection, then go ahead and print or save to a PDF.
If we turn on Gemini (free version) for our students, is there a place in the investigation tool that we can investigate if necessary in regards to results gathered from Gemini?	Gemini use is recorded and saved in Google Vault, just like Gmail, Drive, and such. You can search in Vault to access the prompts and responses for individual users.
Will Gemini flag students with alerts for troubling searches like suicide, drugs, etc.?	Nothing specific has been said about that yet (that I am aware of) although the wording in this article from Google seems to imply some sort of monitoring with the phrase "Bringing Gemini to younger users with supervision tools and controls for parents and educators"
As teachers, is it possible to monitor the prompts input and data generated by students	As far as I know that is currently only available in Google Vault, and teachers typically do not have access to Vault.
Can you add pictures to the stories you create in the Read Along?	Not yet
I watched a video from CDW about licensing changes coming to Education Licensing 2025. They mentioned that this would start in February. I still haven't seen anything change on my account. Anything you know about this? Here is a link that might show you the video if interested.	I would like to watch the video, but the link doesn't work.
