

Attendance

Attendance will be taken in each class.

Safe Arrivals calls home will be made during Period 1 for students who have not yet arrived at school.

For lates and absences in Periods 2-4, Safe Arrivals calls will be made in the evening.

Students must sign out at the main office if they leave during school hours.

School Cash Online

If you have not already registered for School Cash Online at your current school, please do so.

Please visit <https://tdsb.schoolcashonline.com> and select "Get Started Today" and complete the registration process.

Once registered, you will receive email notifications when items become available online.

Students/parents/caregivers are asked to pay for the Student Activity Fee of \$60.00 dollars using School Cash Online. The Student Package includes: a Student Card, a multitude of activities throughout the year, a Yearbook, and the online Agenda App (TDSB Connects).

TDSB Connects App/Student Passwords

Students should download the TDSB Connects App. The TDSB Connects App will give students access to their timetables, the daily school calendar, announcements, the Student Handbook/Credo, and a fillable agenda to populate with their own assignments and events.

TDSB Student account and email access is activated 2-3 days after your first day.

Guidance Google Classroom

Buddies

The Buddies program is a transition program that assists Grade 9 students as they adjust to high school. Each Grade 9 is assigned a Grade 11 or 12 "Buddy" that will be their mentor throughout their Grade 9 year. Buddies run a variety of programming throughout the year, beginning with an orientation day before the school year begins. Buddies will also come into the grade 9 classes throughout the year to run important sessions and stay connected with their students.

Lockers

A combination lock is required. The Main Office sells combination locks for \$6.00 dollars. Payment must be made through School Cash Online. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Calculator Policy

The Mathematics and Science Departments at Lawrence Park Collegiate have standardized the type of calculators used in their courses. This is, in an effort, to create a consistent learning environment for all of our students and to facilitate applicable skill development.

Students in all grades are required to use either **Sharp EL-510RNB Scientific Calculator** or **Sharp EL-510RTB Scientific Calculator**. This is the only type of calculator permitted on the evaluations and exams.
