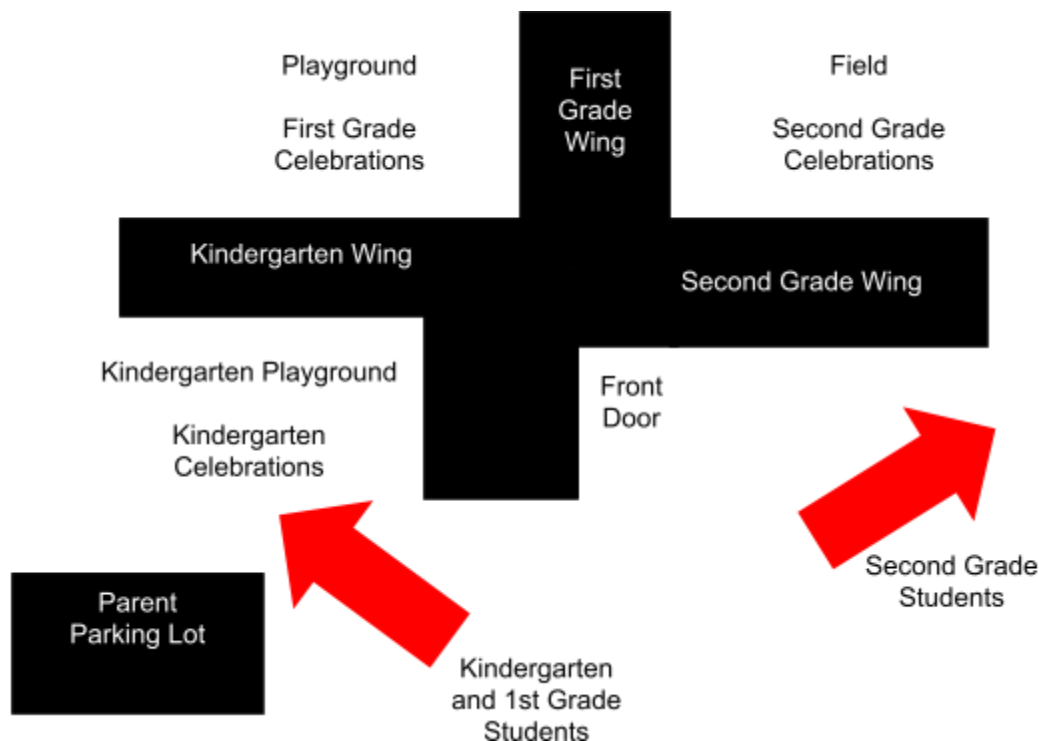

First Day Celebration and Other Information

The Jefferson staff is elated to welcome our students back to Jefferson! We have been working tirelessly to get ready for our students to walk through our doors again while implementing new ways to keep everyone safe! We are looking forward to our First Day Celebration happening on Wednesday for our A Group students and on Thursday for our B Group students. Please come on your child's first day of school from 7:45 until 8. You will get to meet your child's teacher, turn in lunch and milk money, and ask questions you might have.

In order for Jefferson to be able to have a First Day Celebration, although it might look different than in the past, there are certain precautions we will be taking. First, all in attendance will be required to wear a mask the entire time they are on the Jefferson campus. During this event, we will require a mask to be worn by both students and parents. We thank you in advance for respecting this rule and not putting our staff in an uncomfortable position so they can focus on connecting with our amazing students and parents! Playgrounds will not be open for play during the celebration time and we ask that you practice social distancing. When students go inside the building at 8, parents will be asked to say goodbye. Thank you in advance for understanding that these changes are meant to keep the safety of our students and staff at the highest priority.

During the First Day Celebration, teachers will be set up with signs in the various areas marked below on the map. If you have a second grader, you will walk around the right side of the school. If you have a kindergartener or first grader, you will walk around the left side of the school. You will then find your child's teacher.



Teachers will have envelopes for you to use in order to put money in your child's lunch account and/or to buy milk tickets. This can be sent back with the student on another day of school or taken care of and given to your child's teacher at the celebration. If you have a kindergartener, please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and immunization records to turn in to your child's teacher. The office needs a copy of both as part of your child's registration.

We look forward to seeing the many familiar faces and welcoming the new faces to our Jefferson School Family! It is truly going to be joyous to have our students back in our school! We cannot wait!
