

Job Description

Volunteers

Volunteers are staff between the ages of **12-13**, or **anyone older that needs volunteer hours**, who have limited responsibility and are learning how to become Camp Staff Coaches-in-Training (CSTs) in the future. Volunteers are eligible to work both Recreational and Competitive Camps. Volunteers **receive only service hours at the end of their week.**

Volunteer Service Hours and Compensation

Volunteers will receive service completion hours based on how many hours worked over the course of a particular camp week. If a staff receives service hours they are **not** eligible to also receive payment for that specific camp week. Specific service hour details will be outlined in their contract.

Working Conditions

This is an hourly role that has set hours of work depending on the camp week details. The Volunteer must be eligible to work in the U.S.

Responsibilities

- All paperwork completed and turned in
- All onboarding steps must be completed
- All training steps must be completed
- Mandatory staff meeting attended
- Timely communication with Director On Site
- Confirmation of all camp day availability
- Camp survey completed at end of camp week

Coaching Expectations

General

- 1. Work with the Director of Camps and other staff members in a professional manner.
- 2. Place the needs of your campers above your own at all times.
- 3. Come ready and excited for work always be on time.
- 4. Support and take charge of any duties and activities that may be assigned to you.
- 5. Encouraging, engaged, and energetic on field if coaching.
- 6. No cell phone use unless there is an emergency. Can be used before or after camp sessions and must be used during Check In and Check Out.



- 7. Late or missing session, must notify the Director of Camps.
- 8. No foul language and a good example to peers and players.
- 9. Wear appropriate staff uniform provided by Technika Academy. Shorts should be longer than your shirt. Shoes should be cleats, turfs, or tennis shoes.
- 10. Staff survey at the end of each camp week.
- 11. Have fun!
- 12. Learn all your camper's names, if support coaching.

Arrival and Attire

- Monday no later than 6:00 am
- Tuesday no later than 6:30 am
- Wednesday-Friday no later than 7:00 am
- If running late, please notify your Director On Site as soon as possible
- Wear camp t-shirt that has been provided
- Black or blue shorts
- Cleats, turfs, or tennis shoes tied (no lifestyle shoes)
- Please wear a watch
- Hats and sunglasses are ok (take off sunglasses when talking close to players)
- Hair in professional appearance

- Team first attitude
- Speaking, writing, and organizational abilities
- Effective time management skills
- Attention to detail
- Must be at least 12 years of age
