Parking

We utilize self-seeding with approximately 30-second intervals. Please seed yourself accordingly. If you need more time, please ask.

On-course food and fluids

One aid station is available with snacks and water; anticipate providing most of your own food and hydration. It will be located at the top of Radio Tower on Linda Road.

Event Cut-off Time

To ensure event safety and out of respect for volunteers, you will need to start your last stage by 2:45 pm.

Apres

Starts at 3 PM with awards at 5 PM. You must be present to receive the prize.

No dogs allowed. Apres is located a short pedal from Den Duyf Park. Please follow signage, there is no parking available at the venue. Respect our hosts' private property by using the washrooms, cleaning up, and just plain old being a good person. Our catering partner has asked that riders grab food when you arrive at apres to avoid lineups. I repeat, no dogs allowed. Bring cash or a card for apres extras!
