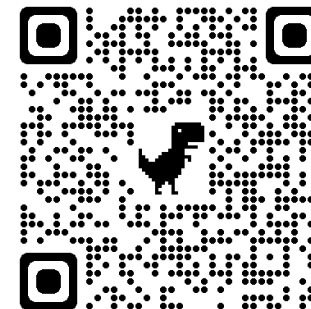
Our intention is having a Fragrance-Free building. Please choose to be fragrance free out of respect for those who are affected by scents.

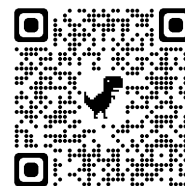

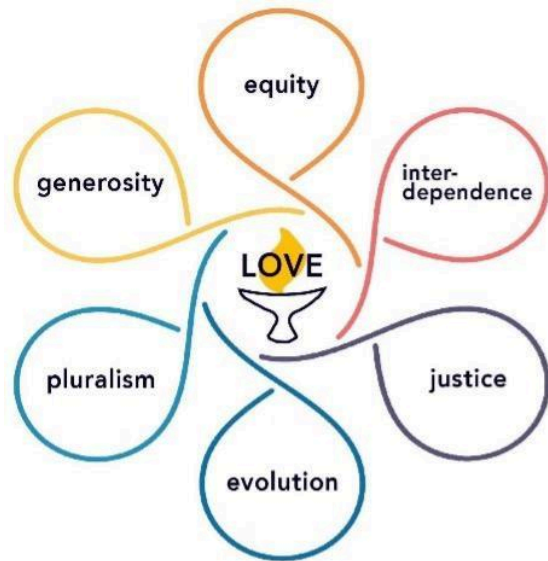
