### **Challenge Cache Moratorium?!!**

*A 1 year halt on all challenge cache publishing gave GCHQ time to rework the rules and guidelines for challenge caches. Post-moratorium challenge caches abide by different restrictions than pre-moratorium challenge caches, which have been 'grandfathered' as is.*

*Moratorium started: April, 2015*

*Moratorium ended: May 25, 2016*
