No two people respond to fillers in exactly the same way. However, you can get an idea of what's possible by viewing before and after pictures. Photos of results experienced by real patients can help you envision your own potential treatment outcome.

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H2 Why People Like Hyaluronic Acid Fillers

There are many different facial fillers out there. Some contain synthetic materials that aren't easy to break down if you decide you don't like them. Others, like hyaluronic acid, contain naturally occurring substances.

One of the top advantages hyaluronic acid fillers have over other types is that they are reversible. For this reason, hyaluronic acid fillers are often recommended for those who have never received dermal fillers before. If you don't like the way they look or have an adverse reaction to them, you aren't stuck with them. They can be dissolved with the injection of a special hyaluronidase solution. As soon as the injection occurs, the filler in the area begins to soften and break down.

H2 What to Expect From Your Filler Appointment

The first thing we'll do when you arrive for your appointment is make sure we clearly understand your treatment expectations. We'll consult with you about your aesthetic concerns and provide recommendations. Then, we'll mark your desired treatment areas to guide injection placement.

Before we inject any fillers into your face, we'll numb the treatment area. We may apply a topical numbing cream or inject a numbing agent. Once you're sufficiently numb, we'll carefully inject the fillers into the previously marked areas. This process only takes a few minutes in most cases. When we're all finished, we'll give you aftercare instructions to keep pain, swelling, and bruising to a minimum.

You should expect to see a difference in your appearance immediately after treatment. However, you won't experience the full results until about three weeks afterward. The results appear gradually as your body produces more collagen and your post-injection swelling goes down.

H2 How to Prepare for Dermal Fillers

It's natural to experience bruising, swelling, and tenderness after getting dermal fillers. These should only occur around injection sites and should resolve on their own over time. However, you may be able to reduce the severity of your symptoms by doing the following before your appointment:

H3 One Week Before Injections

- Avoid over-the-counter blood thinners, such as Aspirin, Aleve, Ibuprofen, and Motrin.
- Avoid supplements that can increase your likelihood of bruising or bleeding, such as vitamin E, garlic, ginkgo biloba, and ginseng.

H3 Two Days Before Injections

- Avoid any type of hair removal, such as tweezing, waxing, and bleaching, on the planned treatment area.
- Avoid topical anti-aging products that can heighten skin sensitivity, including glycolic acid, retinoids, and tretinoin cream.
- Begin taking Arnica to help decrease bruising.

H3 24 Hours Before Injections

- Stop drinking alcoholic beverages.
