## 2025 PSAT/NMSQT Score Report Information

On October 8<sup>th</sup> juniors took the PSAT/NMSQT. Taking an in-school assessment is a big step for students, and it's just the beginning. College Board's BigFuture School helps them do more with their score as they figure out what's next. Scores for juniors were released October 23<sup>rd</sup>, and they will be able to access them on the BigFuture<sup>®</sup> School mobile app (see below for directions). The app is available to students 13 years old and older who've taken the PSAT/NMSQT.

Helping Your Student Access Their Scores Through BigFuture® School Mobile Appj If your student provided a mobile number during exam setup, he/she can view scores on the BigFuture School Mobile App. The mobile app is part of the SAT® Suite and provides secure access.

A text message will be sent from College Board to that mobile number with instructions.

College Board Student Account – if the student elected not to provide his/her mobile number during the pre-administration day:

- 1. Go to: https://studentscores.collegeboard.org/home
- 2. Click: Create an Account (only if the student has not previously created one)
- 3. Follow instructions to create an account
- 4. Once completed the student can access the score report

This option will require the personal (not Bishop Hartley) email address students provided during exam setup. If your student has taken, or is currently taking, an AP course he/she should be able to use that login information to access PSAT/NMSQT scores.

BigFuture School Mobile App

- College and Scholarship Connections (when available). Students can opt in to Connections™ to discover nonprofit colleges, scholarship providers, and programs that match their goals and interests—and are actively looking for students like them.
