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Halleck Vineyard Widens Inner Circle with Monthly Couplets Wine Club

(Sonoma - Feb. 23, 2022) For the first time in 20 years [Halleck Vineyard](#) – an award winning producer of small batch Russian River Valley and Sonoma Coast wines – has introduced a new Monthly Couplet *Inner Circle Wine Club* subscription level that allows new members to receive monthly shipments of one bottle of Pinot Noir and one bottle of white wine.

Previously, *Inner Circle Wine Club* Membership required a 6 bottle per shipment commitment. Inner Circle Members receive first access to purchase limited reserve, award winning wines, and exclusive events. Halleck Vineyard produces limited case runs of award winning wines. New releases sell out quickly. This new Monthly Couplet 2 bottle club level membership is now online and membership is limited to the first 200 subscribers.

“We want to diversify our *Inner Circle Wine Club* membership with the next generation of Pinotphiles,” says vintner Ross Halleck. “If you’re passionate about Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, this is your opportunity to dip your toe in the water.” Monthly Couplet subscribers are guaranteed a monthly allotment of limited reserve wine without having to commit to case quantities.

Monthly Couplet *Inner Circle Wine Club* membership includes a complimentary Sebastopol wine tasting for 2 at the Halleck Vineyard Estate where guests sample each of the varietals they’ll receive as part of their monthly shipments:

- 2020 Sobre Vista Chardonnay (220 cases produced) paired with California grown, dried Turkish-style apricots
- 2021 Calandrelli Vineyard Dry Gewurztraminer (137 cases produced, 98 pts) paired with organic curried quinoa, cilantro, jalapeno, onions, topped with baked tofu & curried aioli
- 2019 Not Your Mother’s Dry White Zinfandel (265 cases produced - 92 pts) paired with Grazing Girl, Valley Ford Cheese and Creamery, Valley Ford
- 2018 Three Sons Cuvee Pinot Noir (353 cases produced - 95 pts) paired with Estero Gold, Valley Ford Cheese and Creamery, Valley Ford

- 2017 Hillside Cuvee Pinot Noir (472 cases produced - 91 pts) paired with Triple Creme Truffle Brie, Marin French Cheese Co., Petaluma
- 2018 Haas Vineyard Pinot Noir 173 cases produced - 99 pts) paired with Pinot Noir-Infused Chocolate Truffle, Sonoma Chocolatiers, Sebastopol

Halleck Vineyard Sonoma wine tasting tickets are 100% transferable and do not expire. The next monthly Couplet Club welcomes first comers to the next generation of Inner Circle Wine Club members.

About Halleck Vineyard

In 2003, Halleck Vineyard – nestled in Sebastopol Hills in the Russian River Valley– won the first place prize at the Pinot Noir Summit for their 2001 Estate Grown Pinot. In 2009, their Estate Grown Pinot Noir earned a perfect rating and called “Extraordinary” by nationally syndicated wine columnist, Dan Berger who wrote, “If I judged wines on a 100 point scale, I wouldn’t take a single point away from this wine.” Nearly a decade later, in 2018, Somm Journal Magazine named Halleck Vineyard as one of the top 5 vineyards in Sonoma County. Since then, under the stewardship of Jenifer and Ross Halleck, Halleck Vineyard wines continue to receive 90+ scores as well as Best In Class, Best in Show, Gold and Double Gold accolades.
