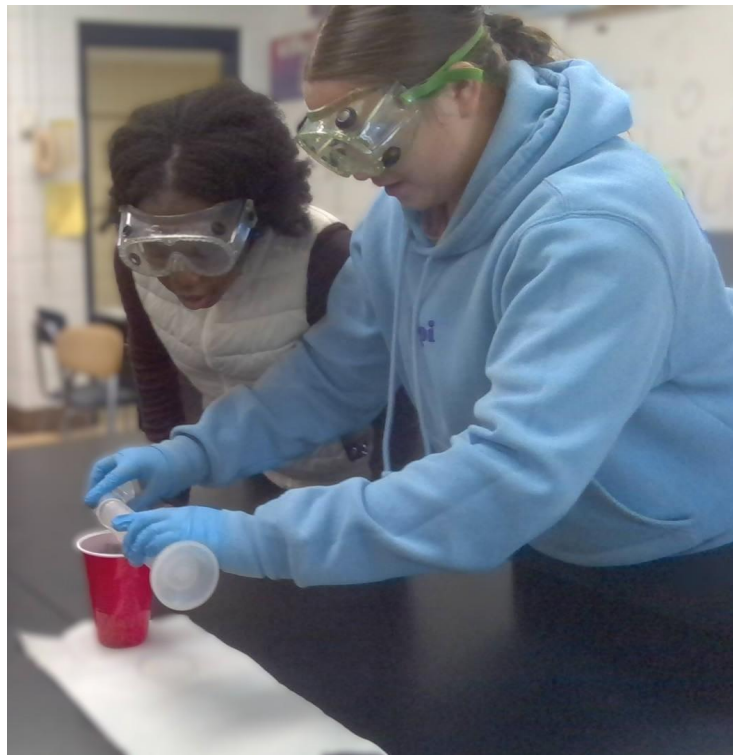
Weird Science

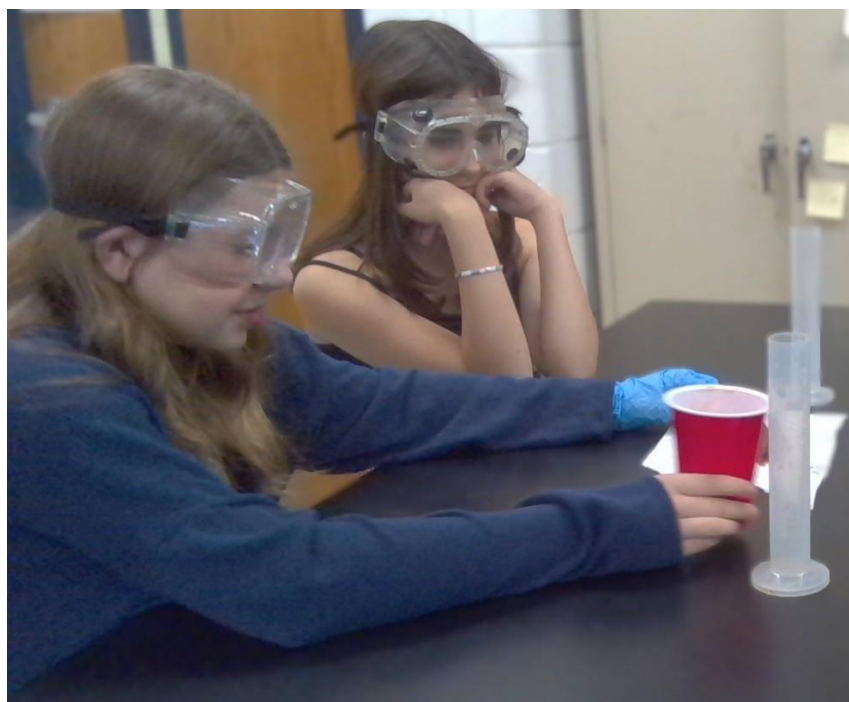
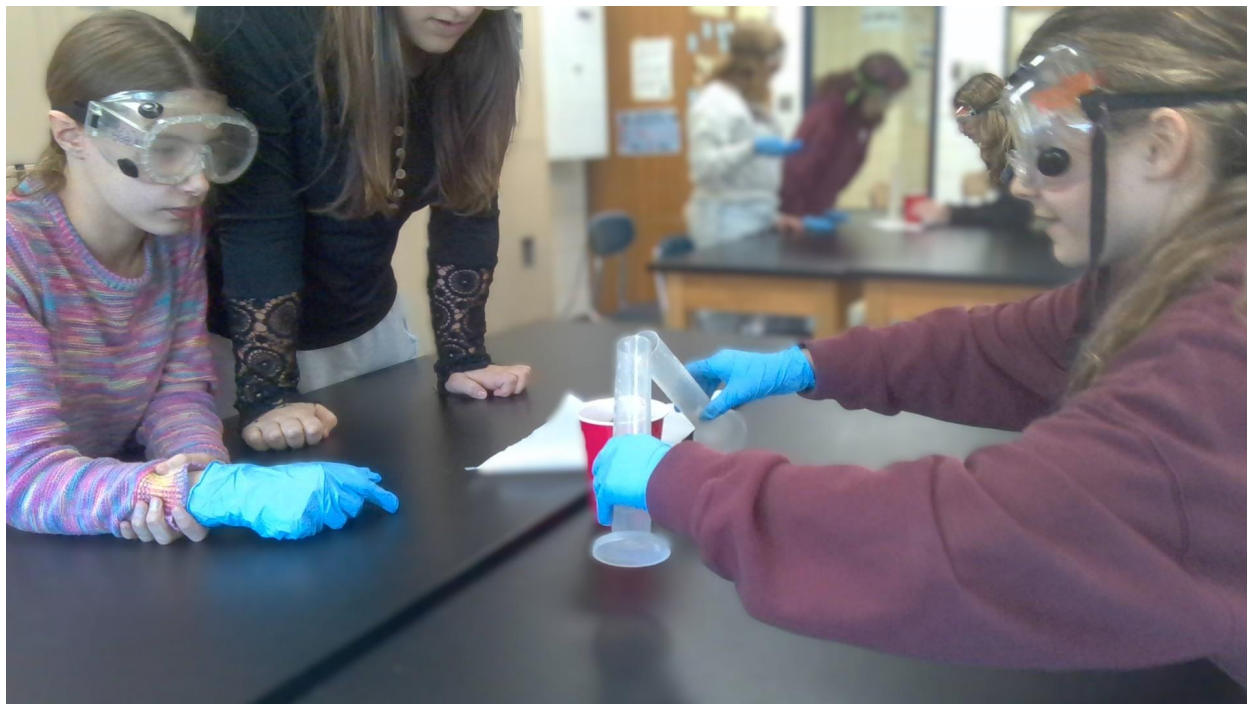
