 - Proposals/designs:
 - include Go's own version in 'go env' <u>41116</u>
 - allow -toolexec tools to opt in to build caching <u>41145</u>
 - support a system-wide GOMODCACHE <u>40895</u>
 - Two proposals that went under the radar last year:
 - query non-defaults in 'go env' 34208
 - allow 'go run' without any arguments <u>36235</u>
 - any thoughts? should they be added to the incoming queue?
 - Should GOFLAGS ignore unknown flags? <u>CL comment</u> by Bryan
 - Should "go test" kill test programs via process groups? <u>24050</u>
 - Turn modules on <u>41330</u>
 - Should "go mod tidy" remove redundant replace directives? <u>30516</u>
 - Support for module renaming/aliasing without requiring replace directives? (peripheral to <u>30831</u>)
 - Status of 1.16
 - Now available please test!
 - Module retraction <u>#240the31</u>
 - go install pkg@version #40276
 - -mod=readonly by default #40728
 - New "all" package pattern
 - Omits dependencies of external tests if go.mod says "go 1.16" or higher.
 - go command tracing
 - Still in progress:
 - GO111MODULE=on
 - Lazy module loading (<u>36460</u>)
 - Includes the new "all" module pattern.
 - File overlays <u>39958</u>
 - (Hopefully) replacement aliasing (26904)
- gopls
 - Issues/proposals
 - From Rebecca:
 - gopls/v0.5.0 was released yesterday please try it out and file bugs.
 - Multi-module workspaces are happening: <u>#32394</u>.
 - Enable it at master with "experimentalWorkspaceModule": true in your settings. Not everything will work yet, but please try it out and file issues.
 - The design doc will be updated as we make progress, so please add comments to that issue if you notice any problems with the design.

 - x/pkgsite: establish guidelines for feature development for pkgsite #40911
