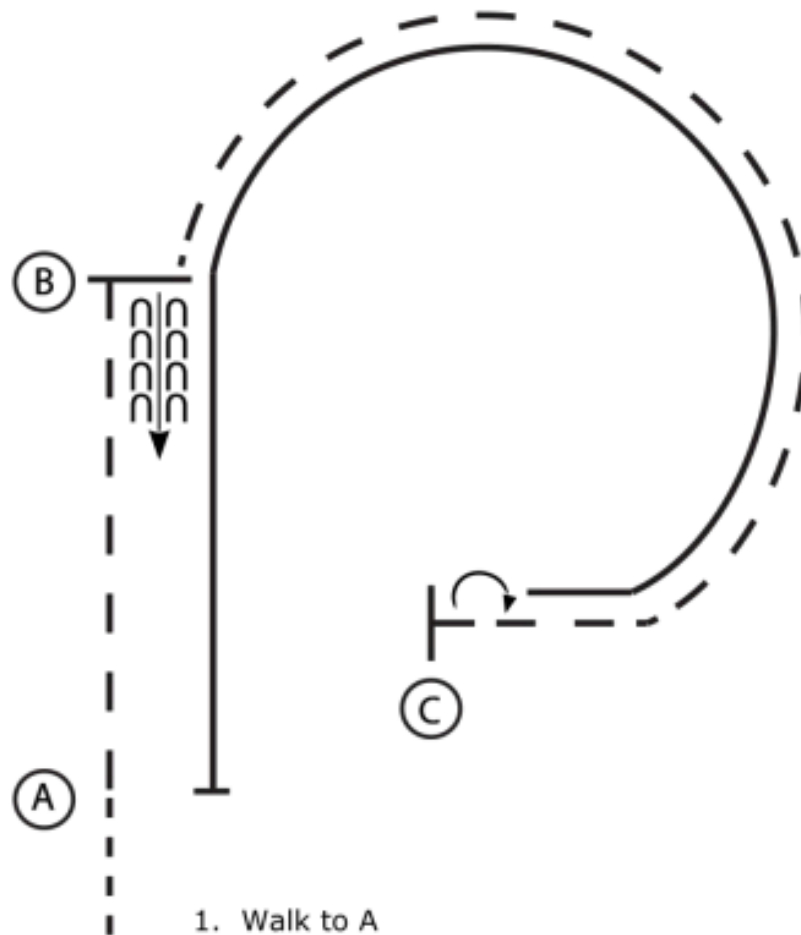

2. Run to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
3. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
6. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
7. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
8. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

2. At A, jog to B
3. Stop at B and perform a 360 degree turn to the left
4. Lope on the left lead around C to D
5. Stop at D and a 180 degree turn to the right
6. Extend the jog in a circle around D
7. Stop at D and perform a 180 degree turn to the left
8. Lope on the left lead to E
9. Stop at E and back 4 steps.

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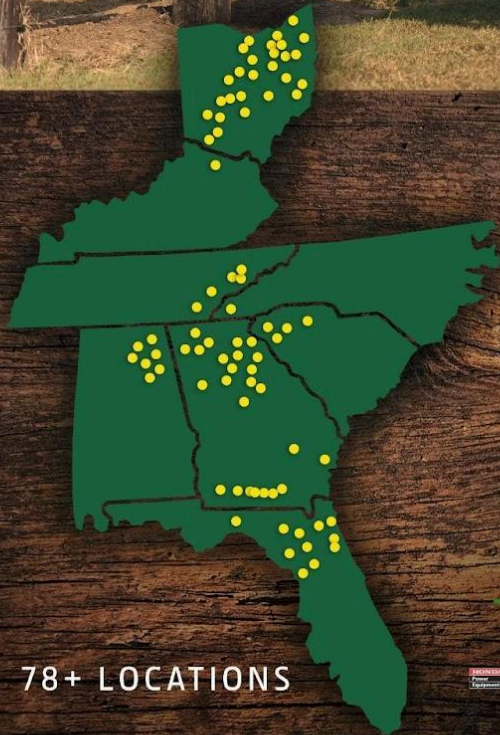
Horse Descriptions

1. **Arod (Circle M)** – White QH, Bouncy but can go slower, two hand option, has a lead change.
2. **Blackie (Circle M)** – Black QH, spur trained, ball spurs only, medium rein.
3. **Bonnie (Riding on Faith)** – Dark bay roan mare. Ride leg to hand, medium rein contact. SPUR STOP. Have legs on before asking to stop. Rides best with head straight and lowered. Use outside rein around turns and spins. Squeeze to back. Release through body to keep her calm to walk. Tall riders could go without spurs. Ball spurs only. 2 hands.
4. **Buck (Riding on Faith)** – Push forward, medium rein. Has great stop and back. Really set up for right lead. Encourage with voice/soft leg around gates, as he will exit the arena if given the opportunity. Crop option. Two hand option, but can be one hand for rail classes. Division appropriate spurs.
5. **Buddy (JPH)** –Medium contact. Lots of left rein, both directions. Very easy to navigate. Lots of leg usually. Spur stop and squeeze to slow. Voice to stop. Ball or rowel spur.
6. **Capri (Champion Hill)** – Do not over que has a big ranch trot. Spur stop trained. Do not trap in the bridle. Voice cues are good. NO spurs.
7. **Cash (Winning Edge)** – Soft, slow hand. 2 hand option and division appropriate spurs.
8. **Charlie (Riding on Faith)** – Sorrel with blaze. Medium rein contact, keep his head in front of shoulders. Two hand option. Set up left lead. He can be lazy! Ride with a soft leg while moving and push forward when using hand. Has an easy jog and rocking horse lope if you just pilot him along. Sit back, softly pull and squeeze to back. Division appropriate spurs. He has a very delayed whoa at times and doesn't have timely departures once he's tired. Crop option, but needs to be used on his shoulder.
9. **Cleo (JPH)** - Grey AQHA mare. Division appropriate spurs. One hand squeeze legs to slow down. Older all around/pleasure mare. Very much point and shoot type of draw.
10. **Cookie (Winning Edge)** – Do not over bridle. Stay very soft and slow with hand. Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
11. **Cowgirl (Arnold)** – AQHA Red roan mare. Light contact. Keep inside leg off when loping (she will change leads if applied). Has a spur stop. No spurs.
12. **Dually (JPH)** – Great draw. Uncomplicated reiner. Slightly bend to the inside on fast circles. Division appropriate spurs. Medium contact, one hand.
13. **Gabby (Arnold)** – Chestnut QH mare. Light rein contact. Support with hand and use leg to collect. Division Appropriate Spurs.
14. **Garth (Circle M)** – Roan Ranch horse. Medium rein contact, stay out of his face. Use seat and feet out to stop. Hum to slow. Keep outside leg pressure when loping. Two hand option. Ball spurs only.
15. **Gus (Winning Edge)** – Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
16. **Hope (Champion Hill)** – Set up for leads. Spur stop trained. Will drop in so use leg to keep her in. Ball spurs only.
17. **Irish (Riding on Faith)** – Push and bump with legs to keep going. Will not keep moving if too tight on face. Ride with little leg, use seat and hand. Squeeze and pull to back. Medium rein contact. Two hands for pattern but can be one hand for rail.
18. **Jerl (Circle M)** – Older reiner, medium rein, division appropriate spurs, has lead change.

19. **Joey (Champion Hill)** – Work into bridle, great pattern horse. Lots of leg to pivot; don't drag or will back up. Division appropriate spurs.
20. **Liz (Champion Hill)** – 2-hand, post to trot. Quiet hand to leg for spin. Hum to slow. Gets hot in the center – hold. No spurs.
21. **Max (Circle M)** – QH gelding. Spur trained, balls spurs only. Easy to ride. Do not keep pushing at the lope. He is just that slow.
22. **Nubby (JPH)** – Sorrel/AQHA. Medium contact, two hands. Easy draw. Lots of leg at the lope. Very push button type. Use your voice for transitions. Division appropriate spurs.
23. **Opie (Circle M)** – White QH – Stay light on face. Spur trained. Roll spurs to put head down, squeeze to slow.
24. **Rebel (JPH)** – Ball spurs only, tighter rein. Great draw if you keep him collected. One or two hand option. Very easy going.
25. **Sarge (Circle M)** – Ball spurs only, two hand option, support right lead.
26. **Scooby (Riding on Faith)** – Pretty simple ride. Recommend two hands, especially for patterns. If confident rider, can one hand the rail classes. Medium rein contact. He listens very well to voice commands. Cluck to trot and squeeze with both legs. To slow his trot sit and say easy. To stop say whoa and sit. To back – kiss/say “back” and gently pull and release.
27. **Shotgun (Circle M)** – Reiner, division appropriate spurs. 2 hand option.
28. **Sterling (Circle M)** – White QH. Spur trained, squeeze to slow. Medium rein contact. Ball spurs.
29. **Tie (Winning Edge)** – Set up for leads. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
30. **Willy (Circle M)** – Sorrel QH, spur trained, needs a lot of leg loping.



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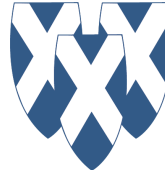

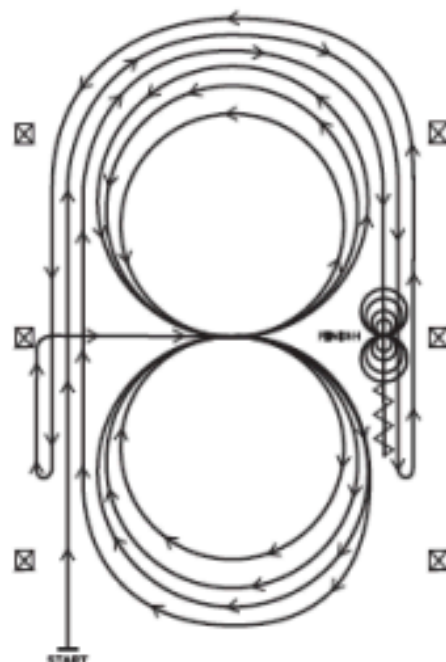


Ranch Riding Pattern 3



1. Lope left lead down the center past end marker and stop
2. 1 1/2 spins right
3. Lope right lead to center and continue loping a small slow circle to the right
4. Change leads
5. Lope large fast circle to the left
6. Stop, back 6 steps
7. Turn 1 1/4 spins left
8. Extended trot and stop even with the end cone.

NRHA Pattern 3



1. Beginning, lope straight up the left side of the arena, circle the top end of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
2. Continue straight up the right side of the arena circle back around the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
3. Continue up the left side of the arena to the center marker. At the center marker, the horse should be on the right lead. Guide the horse to the center of the arena on the right lead and complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads in the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Continue up the left side of the arena, circle the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

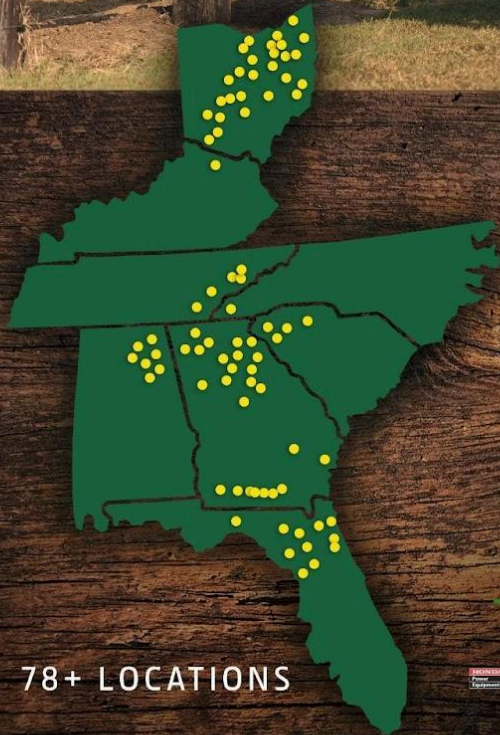
Horse Descriptions

1. **Arod (Circle M)** – White QH, Bouncy but can go slower, two hand option, has a lead change.
2. **Blackie (Circle M)** – Black QH, spur trained, ball spurs only, medium rein.
3. **Bonnie (Riding on Faith)** – Dark bay roan mare. Ride leg to hand, medium rein contact. SPUR STOP. Have legs on before asking to stop. Rides best with head straight and lowered. Use outside rein around turns and spins. Squeeze to back. Release through body to keep her calm to walk. Tall riders could go without spurs. Ball spurs only. 2 hands.
4. **Buck (Riding on Faith)** – Push forward, medium rein. Has great stop and back. Really set up for right lead. Encourage with voice/soft leg around gates, as he will exit the arena if given the opportunity. Crop option. Two hand option, but can be one hand for rail classes. Division appropriate spurs.
5. **Buddy (JPH)** –Medium contact. Lots of left rein, both directions. Very easy to navigate. Lots of leg usually. Spur stop and squeeze to slow. Voice to stop. Ball or rowel spur.
6. **Capri (Champion Hill)** – Do not over que has a big ranch trot. Spur stop trained. Do not trap in the bridle. Voice cues are good. NO spurs.
7. **Cash (Winning Edge)** – Soft, slow hand. 2 hand option and division appropriate spurs.
8. **Charlie (Riding on Faith)** – Sorrel with blaze. Medium rein contact, keep his head in front of shoulders. Two hand option. Set up left lead. He can be lazy! Ride with a soft leg while moving and push forward when using hand. Has an easy jog and rocking horse lope if you just pilot him along. Sit back, softly pull and squeeze to back. Division appropriate spurs. He has a very delayed whoa at times and doesn't have timely departures once he's tired. Crop option, but needs to be used on his shoulder.
9. **Cleo (JPH)** - Grey AQHA mare. Division appropriate spurs. One hand squeeze legs to slow down. Older all around/pleasure mare. Very much point and shoot type of draw.
10. **Cookie (Winning Edge)** – Do not over bridle. Stay very soft and slow with hand. Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
11. **Cowgirl (Arnold)** – AQHA Red roan mare. Light contact. Keep inside leg off when loping (she will change leads if applied). Has a spur stop. No spurs.
12. **Dually (JPH)** – Great draw. Uncomplicated reiner. Slightly bend to the inside on fast circles. Division appropriate spurs. Medium contact, one hand.
13. **Gabby (Arnold)** – Chestnut QH mare. Light rein contact. Support with hand and use leg to collect. Division Appropriate Spurs.
14. **Garth (Circle M)** – Roan Ranch horse. Medium rein contact, stay out of his face. Use seat and feet out to stop. Hum to slow. Keep outside leg pressure when loping. Two hand option. Ball spurs only.
15. **Gus (Winning Edge)** – Leg off and whoa to stop. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
16. **Hope (Champion Hill)** – Set up for leads. Spur stop trained. Will drop in so use leg to keep her in. Ball spurs only.
17. **Irish (Riding on Faith)** – Push and bump with legs to keep going. Will not keep moving if too tight on face. Ride with little leg, use seat and hand. Squeeze and pull to back. Medium rein contact. Two hands for pattern but can be one hand for rail.
18. **Jerl (Circle M)** – Older reiner, medium rein, division appropriate spurs, has lead change.
19. **Joey (Champion Hill)** – Work into bridle, great pattern horse. Lots of leg to pivot; don't drag or will back up. Division appropriate spurs.

20. **Liz (Champion Hill)** – 2-hand, post to trot. Quiet hand to leg for spin. Hum to slow. Gets hot in the center – hold. No spurs.
21. **Max (Circle M)** – QH gelding. Spur trained, balls spurs only. Easy to ride. Do not keep pushing at the lope. He is just that slow.
22. **Nubby (JPH)** – Sorrel/AQHA. Medium contact, two hands. Easy draw. Lots of leg at the lope. Very push button type. Use your voice for transitions. Division appropriate spurs.
23. **Opie (Circle M)** – White QH – Stay light on face. Spur trained. Roll spurs to put head down, squeeze to slow.
24. **Rebel (JPH)** – Ball spurs only, tighter rein. Great draw if you keep him collected. One or two hand option. Very easy going.
25. **Sarge (Circle M)** – Ball spurs only, two hand option, support right lead.
26. **Scooby (Riding on Faith)** – Pretty simple ride. Recommend two hands, especially for patterns. If confident rider, can one hand the rail classes. Medium rein contact. He listens very well to voice commands. Cluck to trot and squeeze with both legs. To slow his trot sit and say easy. To stop say whoa and sit. To back – kiss/say “back” and gently pull and release.
27. **Shotgun (Circle M)** – Reiner, division appropriate spurs. 2 hand option.
28. **Sterling (Circle M)** – White QH. Spur trained, squeeze to slow. Medium rein contact. Ball spurs.
29. **Tie (Winning Edge)** – Set up for leads. 2 hand option, division appropriate spurs.
30. **Willy (Circle M)** – Sorrel QH, spur trained, needs a lot of leg loping.



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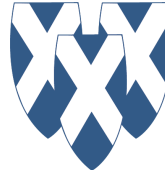
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
