

Setting Internet Browser Language

Change the language of your Chrome browser (Windows & Chromebook only)

You can set Chrome to show all settings and menus in the language that you want. This option is only available on Windows and Chromebook computers.

1. On your computer, open Chrome.
2. At the top right, click More  > Settings.
3. At the bottom, click Advanced.
4. Under 'Languages', click Language.
5. Next to the language that you'd like to use, click More  . If the language isn't listed, add it by clicking Add languages.
6. Click Display Google Chrome in this language or Display Chrome OS in this language. This option is only available on Windows and Chromebook computers.
7. Restart Chrome to apply the changes.

Change the language of your Chrome browser (Mac only)

On Mac or Linux? Chrome will automatically display in the default system language for your computer. This also works for the Safari Browser.

1. On your Mac, choose Apple menu  > System Preferences, then click Language & Region.
2. Click General.
3. Do any of the following:
 - a. *Add a language*: Click the Add button  , select one or more languages in the list, then click Add.
 - b. *Change the primary language*: Drag a different preferred language to the top of the Preferred languages list.

How to Specify Preferred Languages in Firefox

1. In Firefox, select the **hamburger** (3 horizontal bars) at the top right corner of the menu bar.
2. Select **Options**.
3. In **General** preferences, scroll down to the **Language and Appearance** section.

4. Under **Language**, select your desired language under **Choose the languages used to display menus, messages, and notifications from Firefox** by selecting **Search for more languages**.
5. In **Firefox Language Settings**, the browser's current default language is shown in order of preference. To choose another language, select **Select a language to add**.
6. Scroll through the alphabetical language list and select the language of your choice. To move it into the active list, select **Add**.

Your new language should now be added to the list. By default, the new language displays first in order of preference. To change its order, use the **Move Up** and **Move Down** buttons accordingly. To remove a specific language from the preferred list, select it and select **Remove**.
