• Tony Hiatt (Director of Elementary Education)

- Mr. Hiatt celebrated the amount of parents in attendance & participation of our PTA. He reminded those in attendance that our students are at the center of our partnership.
- He shared some highlights from the recent <u>PV Annual Report.</u> Highlights include:
 - We are growing approximately 100-150 students per year in PV
 - We continue to increase in diversity across the district
 - He highlighted the importance of attendance and celebrated the strength of attendance across the district.
 - Our district remains committed to Character Counts & finding ways to integrate the pillars into instruction.
 - Related to student data, Mr. Hiatt highlighted our commitment to growth for ALL students.
 - He also highlighted that our principal, Mrs. Richardson was a finalist for the lowa Elementary Principal of the Year!
- A parent asked the question of whether field trips will be returning at the elementary level. Mr. Hiatt shared that field trips are back and that the district continues to explore options and opportunities for a district of our size. There is currently a goal of 2 high quality field trip experiences per grade level.
- Dr. Wagle (PV School Board President) explained the Board's excitement for closing the learning loss experienced due to the Pandemic. He thanked teachers, administrators & parents for their tireless work.
