### **Zoning report - Andy**

- 1941 Letterly St
  - o Multi family rehabbing of structure with off street parking
    - Wanted to add 2 new units
    - Vote was 23 in favor, unanimously in favor of allowing variance
    - Developer, JJ is local to neighborhood, and has done several other small-scale projects

- Meetings will be in person moving forward at Fireball Printing
- November Sneak Peak
  - Large multifamily project at 2001 Lehigh Ave (157 units)
  - o EKNA is not overseeing RCO, but has influence, so please attend if you are able
  - Details of community hearing will be sent out (November 6, 6:30pm, via Zoom)

#### **NKCDC**

- Talked about changes happening in the neighborhood
  - o New toolkit was posted on their instagram (New Kensington Plan) to help local businesses and nonprofits
  - o These include resources to helping folks form groups, local engagement, etc.
  - O Question from audience on concern of cleaning up Kensington Ave without comprehensive plan to address other quality of life issues (lack of housing, drug usage, crime, etc.)
  - NKCDC will send another rep to attend next board meeting to update board on property portfolio in East Kensington, as well as update members at next meeting

## Rails to Trails Program - Anya

- Context given for countywide plan (800 miles planned in the whole network in PA)
- 180 miles are currently ready for use by the public
- Richmond Industrial Viaduct Trail will be 8 miles total when done
  - o 40,000 people live within a half mile of this stretch
  - Will be able to be used recreationally, but also enough width on trail for passive recreation
  - Anya, the rep from the national Rails to Trails Program, shared photos and renderings of what the space could look like
  - o Potential to connect it to the Delaware River Trail, and up to American Street
  - Local organizations (ASE) created art along the trail
- Stressed the importance of new development to include space for the future trail
  - Maintenance agreements are tough and ongoing
- I-95 trail under highway could connect to Richmond Lehigh Viaduct Trail
- Local support is essential to compelling the city to support the project
  - o Richmond Industrial Viaduct Trail is on the Master Transportation Plan for Philly, but low on the priority list
- They encourage EKNA residents to contact the Managing Director's Office at OTIS, council members to keep pressure on this project
- Cost of the trail and infrastructure around is not available yet (but would be many millions of dollars)
- Suggestion from audience on making a Friends of Richmond Trail group Anya supported the idea, since local EKNA members leading advocacy will go a lot farther in terms of influence on city council
- America grants has a funding opportunity for a small landscaping project along the corridor, could spruce up corridor, show continued interest

## **Mini Grants - Andy**

- Encourage folks, even individuals to apply for mini grants
- We want to spend this money in the community, offering grants for new projects
- Still determining how frequently we want to do these rounds with the community (bi-annually? quarterly?)

# **Elections - Andy**

- Encourage people to run for open positions in November
- To run, members must have attended 3 general membership meetings (either in-person or virtually) in the past 6 months
- The election general membership meeting may count as the 3rd meeting
