The Senate discusses the options of moving the bus tokens to the Bookstore for students to be able to pay with credit card, debit card, and access bus tokens for the Promise Program. Student Senate has heard that students prefer purchasing bus tokens at the Cashier's Office as it is closest to the Bus Stop. Because the Cashier's Office can access students' accounts, the logs of how many tokens are purchased by students can be tracked through Student Body Cards.

Commissioner of Activities Shonette moved to keep the student bus tokens to be sold at the Cashier's Office with the condition that promise students could still get their free bus tokens. Seconded by Senator Eden.
