- Provide a cover page that includes title, your name, age level telephone number, and word count

OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS

- Open to students and adults who attend ACTS Church
- Essay, artwork, multimedia presentation, or video must be the original work of the participant.
- Essay, artwork, multimedia presentation, or video must include that information such as cover page or title scene of a video that includes the following: Title, Full Name, phone number, age, word count (essay only)
- Essay, artwork, multimedia presentation, or video will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Creativity (Think outside of the box)
 - o Cultural Knowledge, Structure, and historical relevance
 - o Clarity (spelling, grammar, and punctuation) or quality of video or artwork
 - o Essay should be typed, written in English, and within word length for age level
 - All contest presentations must be submitted online at <u>actseducationassociation.nlr@gmail.com</u> or given to a member of AEA.
 - Essays. artwork, multimedia presentations, or videos must remain on topic and answer prompt questions fully.
 - o Artwork be must be no larger than 24 inches by 36 inches
 - o Video must be no more than 2 minutes long.
- Contest will now be open until February 4, 2024. Submissions and products such as artwork will be due Sunday, February 4, 2024. Please see a member of AEA to bring in any artwork. (Sis. Yvonne Bolden, Sis. Vakeisa Jones, Sis. Tyronza Walker, or Sis. Sabreena Lee)
- Submissions for the contest cannot be revised or altered once submitted. **Please see the third page to see specific guidelines for each category.**
