

- 1. To access Google Classroom, students should go to www.google.com.
- 2. They should sign in using their ISA username which is the first letter of the first name followed immediately by their full surname@isa.aberdeen.sch.uk. E.g. Lulu Smoor's username is lsmoor@isa.aberdeen.sch.uk
- 3. Their password will be a unique combination of *colouranimalnumber* which they should all know e.g *pinkelephant51*.
- 4. Once signed in, they should click on the 9 small dots in the top right corner of the Google Homepage and select Google Classroom.
- 5. Then Select 'Home Learning 2025-26' classroom. NB If they have not joined the class, they can add it using the + in the top right corner, and entering the code: w2zb3bqz
- 6. Open the post called 'Home Learning wb 25th August' and click on the google doc to see the instructions for home learning.
- 7. All home learning is assigned on Monday with various deadlines throughout the week, e.g. sentences due each Wednesday, Maths on Friday, and reading for on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings.
- 8. Over the week, students are expected to work through the tasks in the first 3 columns: Spelling, Novel Study and Maths, and then have the option of completing some of the tasks in 4th column.

Snack

We are an **allergy aware school**. Please ensure no products containing nuts are brought into school. Students will have the opportunity to eat a **small snack** in the classroom at approximately 10:15 am each day. We encourage students to make healthy choices, and to use reusable packaging to reduce waste.

Lunch

You can find a link to the current menus on the Community Hub. Here is a <u>link</u> to the menus until December. If your child is having school lunch, please discuss their choices with them before they come to school.

Recess

Please make sure your child has a named waterproof jacket for recess times **everyday**. We try to get the children outside in all weathers as much as possible!

Home Learning

From 25th August, Grade 3 students will be set home learning each week. All details will be on their Grade 3 Homework Google Classroom. Students will be responsible for checking their Google Classroom account to see their homework assignments each week.

Art

On Wednesday and Thursdays (G3S) and Thursday and Fridays (G3H), students will have art. They would benefit from wearing something appropriate, so that if a little paint or other art medium gets on to their clothes then it's not a problem. Aprons are provided in the classroom but older clothes are a perfect choice on these two days.

PE

G3H students will have PE on Wednesday and Thursdays, while G3S will have PE on Thursday and Fridays. They must bring a PE kit to school to change into. Please check the <u>supply list</u> for details about the kit. Students should have a black Dri Fit PE T-shirt which can be ordered from <u>Spirit Wear</u> on the Community Hub. Please order this using the spiritwear form and it will be delivered to class. They should also bring shorts, sweatpants/ joggers or leggings - these can be any colour, a sweatshirt or hoodie which they have not worn to school. If students are waiting for their PE T-shirt to arrive then they should bring in an alternative T-shirt. They can wear their trainers to school, but these should be clean, and not muddy!

Your child will visit the school library each Tuesday. They should bring their library bag with them to school on Tuesdays. New students will receive their library bag at their first Library class.
