- Get water in the TD tent

SCHEDULE

- Registration starts at 8:00 next to the Hole 1 tee
- Players meeting at 9:30, same as above
- Round 1 is scheduled to start at 10:00 on Saturday 11th of June
- Round 2, scheduled to start one hour after all cards finish round 1 and have submitted their scores.
- Round 3 will start at 10:00 on Sunday 12th of June
- Final 9 round starts 30 minutes after all cards finish the round and had submitted their scores

All three rounds will be shotgun start. Groups will be within your division as much as possible. Between each round groups will be adjusted based on event score. The groups for Saturday's morning round will be published Thursday evening before the event.

PARKING

Dinton Pastures has two main car parks (and some around). The closest o Hole 1 is the **Activity Centre Car Park** and the second one is near **Hole 10**. There are other small ones dotted around, but those two should be able to allocate all the players. Please arrive early. The cost of the car park is **£6** for the full day, it is **pay and display** or pay via the **RingGo** app.

FOOD, DRINKS AND TOILETS

Food is available at the Activity Centre and the Firefly Cafe, but due to the limited amount of time between rounds, it is advised to pack your own food and water. Toilets are available at the Activity Centre and at the Firefly Cafe. The overall map shows their location in relation to the car parks and disc golf holes.

COURSE LAYOUT

For both rounds of the tournament, we will be playing a modified white layout of the Dinton Pastures course. If you are unfamiliar with this layout you can <u>watch this video</u>. A hole by hole breakdown of the layout is provided at the end of this document.

CASUAL RELIEF

If a disc ends up in an unsafe area to establish a lie e.g. bushes with thorns, unstable branches/terrain, casual relief is allowed. Barbed wire has 2 meters relief.

SCORE KEEPING

Two players from each card should keep the score using the official PDGA scoring platform. Please double or triple check your scores before submitting them to the PDGA online scoring platform.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

 Dinton Pastures Country Park is a public space and park goers take priority over disc golf


- No card should tee off without having the hole clear of park goers or other cards
- The grass in some (most) of the fairways is very tall (the park does not allow us to cut it). Please split the card and at least two people spot for the throws (and any other hazard) in holes where the grass is long. In particular hole 1, 4,5(both sides of the Fairways), 7,10,11 (easy to lose a disc if not spotting) and 13.
- Due to the nature of the teepads, please take care when throwing as some stances
 might be hazardous to play from. In the case that a teepad becomes dangerous due to
 the weather and/or usage during the day please use common sense and tee in a slightly
 different position to either side of the tee pad. Safety comes first.






Course map




















