Bio

Artist Scholar, **Calvin Stalvig** (1986), creates sculpture, installation, works on paper, digital collage, video, and performance. Raised in a family of folk painters, assemblage artists, and stage actors, his work is an alchematization of the everyday ordinary into sacred symbol and relationships infused with animate spirit. Working in metal, wood, plaster, glass, paint, wool, and found objects, he uses repetition to create dense compositions, charged with a child's curiosity and love for the material world.

Born and raised on Gitch-gaami Lake Superior, his work meditates on historic and intimate social violence, human's dissociation from great nature, water memory, geologic time, Ancestor worship, and is a ritual practice intent on restoring severed relationships with Others.
