Bowling Rams Booster Club Membership Meeting

On January 15, 2026 the booster club meeting held via zoom was called to order at 7:15pm by President Tim Belloff.

A vote was also held on the Facebook of the time of the meeting and that the meeting would be held virtually via Zoom. Vote was held with the majority requesting a 7pm meeting time. Due to this change, attendees were given an extra 15 minutes to log into the meeting before the meeting was called to order.

1. President Report:

2. Vice President Report:

3. Treasurer Report:

Kerri reported that she made a deposit of \$760 (\$620 in cash and a check for \$140). There is a total of \$983.01 in the account and Patty current has \$50 in cash for the candy sales.

Acceptance of the minutes from the December 17, 2025: President requested a motion, made by: Monica Rousset, Seconded by: Kerri Smith. All were in favor with no nays voiced.

Acceptance of the officer's reports: President requested a motion, made by: Monica Rousset, Seconded by: Rick Smith. All were in favor with no nays voiced.

4. Old Business:

Fundraising:

Candy Sale: Is going extremely well. Better than originally thought. A huge thank you to Patty Youmans for heading up the candy sale. Excellent job by the Youmans family who have sold in excess of 90 bars and the Rousset family who have sold excess of 70 bars.

Also, to the kids working together selling candy bars and ball raffle tickets during league nights at Earl Bowl. It went so well that we were concerned we would not have enough candy for the two events at the high school where we are permitted to sell at. Therefore, Quakertown Bowling team had some extras they were willing to sell to us at a discount (150 bars for \$225). This was done in lieu of making another purchase of 700 bars (the minimum amount) from Gertrude Hawk.

Dine and Donate: Reminder: Chipotle in Souderton is Monday January 19, 2026, from 4pm to 9pm. Tell all your friends and family. 25% gets donated back to the Booster Club.

Ball Raffles: 2 bowling balls have been donated to the booster club for us to raffle off. President Belloff talked about different ways we can do this for it to be successful (selling tickets at the SOL tournament that is being held at our home alley, away matches and other league nights). The group discussed price and the consensus was \$10/ticket. The group also discussed having the option of Venmo for the ball raffle. President Tim Belloff offered his Venmo until we can get one established specifically for the Booster Club. This first ball was donated by Carlos Cartagena of the Earl Bowl Earlington Pro Shop. Therefore, this raffle is 100% profit for the booster club. The ball raffle for ball one will be held on January 28, 2026 after the match and we are attempting to live stream the drawing on our Facebook page. The plan for the second ball is to sell raffle tickets at the SOL tournament and raffle it off that day however we need to confirm with Morgan McMullin.

50/50: President Tim Belloff asked Kevin Rousset to be the chair of the 50/50 committee. Kevin Rousset reported that he has the tickets (2,000) on hand and will be donated to the cause from the Rousset family. Tim stated he believes we can sell tickets at the SOL tournament at Earl Bowl in February but will need to confirm from Morgan McMullin just to be sure.

Spirit Wear: The Bowling Rams spirit store is available, and the group discussed the dates to open and close the store so spirit wear gear can be processed and obtained. The gear is not processed until the store is closed. The store was extended from the originally date of January 12, 2026 to January 15, 2026. Nevertheless the store has closed and we have made \$62 as a result of 8 orders.

Superbowl Block Pool: Kevin Rousset suggested we engage in a Superbowl block pool as a fundraising opportunity. Tim Belloff asked if anyone would be willing to do it. Kerri Smith volunteered Rick Smith who agreed to head it up. \$10/block x 100 blocks equal \$1,000 with half of it being paid out to the winners of the pool. Therefore, \$500 to the booster club. A motion was requested by President Tim Belloff, made by Kevin Rousset and seconded by Rick Smith. All were in favor for no nays voiced. Thank you, Rick! A discussion ensued on what if we do not sell all the blocks. If this were the case, we could refund the money or have the booster club purchase the remaining blocks and any winnings would be for the booster club.

5. Jerseys/Shammies

President Tim Belloff reported that the jerseys have been ordered for the team. The total was \$1,157.02. Tim reported that he would like provide the seniors their jersey as a

7. New Business

Therefore, President Tim Belloff was going to see if a Friday night or two was available and if either of those dates worked better for the majority of the group. The food for the banquet will be pot luck via sign up genius like last year as the consensus was that is was successful.

Other/Feedback/Suggestions from Membership: Kevin Rousset wanted to comment for the record what an excellent job President Tim Belloff is doing with the booster club Facebook page. The information is there for the membership and tips and advice for the bowlers as well. Well done, Tim!

No other feedback or suggestions were presented. Therefore, a motion by the president was requested for adjournment; Kevin Rousset affirmed and seconded by Monica Rousset Youmans. Meeting was adjourned at 8:17pm
