

Do you remember what you wanted to do after you graduated from high school?

We were at the end of the Cultural Revolution and we had to follow this government's orders, not just do whatever you wanted.

Do you want to go to university like us?

We didn't go to college then, it was a two-year selection process for the workers, peasants and soldiers, and only those who had that could go to school, and only those who had someone in their family who was a cadre, so we common people couldn't go to college.

What did you do after you graduated from high school? What did the state assign you to do?

We were arranged by the government. I worked in a factory for a year and then became an accountant.

Did you have any different ideas about what you wanted to do? You didn't?

I didn't have any such idea, and it was impossible to realise it. At that time, if you set up a stall on the street, you were speculating, and everything had to be arranged by the motherland and the government. The government uh didn't arrange for me to go to the countryside because we were sisters my sister had already gone to the countryside, and the secretary didn't arrange

for me to be inserted in the army as a youth, so he arranged for me to be a labourer in a small factory.

My mum died when I was ten.

It was the factory that made the paper boxes.

Oh, you worked in a factory making paper boxes, and then you became an accountant after a year?

There weren't many high school students then.

How old were you when you got married, Grandma?

I got married at 24.

Oh, you didn't get married too early in your day.

In our time, city people had to be 23 years old to get married, country people were 22, and we were considered city people.

Oh, and was your marriage arranged by your parents or was it a free love affair?

Free love. He was in my class.

Grandpa was in your class?

Ah, from the same street again.

Then the first person you liked was Grandpa.

When did Grandpa fall in love with you?

He said he liked me when he was very young. We were in the same class.

Then he came back from the countryside to find you. And before he went to the country, did he, when you were in

high school, did he ever talk to you about it?

We didn't talk either. At that time we had a saying that because my sister wasn't married, because my sister was two years older than me, and she wasn't married, I couldn't get married, and I could only get married after she did. Otherwise it's not good for her.

So how long after you got married did you have children?

One year of marriage?

One year and you had a father?

What were you doing at that time?

I was working as an accountant. I was working as an accountant after I had Dad.

How do you think you're doing as an accountant?

I'm pretty good at it. People say I'm skilled. I'm good.

Do you like it?

I love it.

What was Grandpa doing then?

Grandpa worked as a custodian at the agricultural machinery station, and then when the youths returned to the city, he went to the hospital.

You usually have to be in contact with grandpa, and dad, after you get married, and have a baby, then you have to be with?

I lived with that father of mine, I didn't go to their

house.

You didn't go to their house.

Ah I stayed with my father, I stayed in my father's house and then my father financed us with a new house, and I said I lived with my father, not with their family.

So after your sister married did she go with is with her husband? Or was she at home too?

She married into someone else's family.

Then why are you in your own house?

I'm here on the street with my dad and he has to live with me.

So your dad needs you to look after him?

Not to his son's house, he said he wanted to live with me, he preferred to stay with me because my father loved me since I was a child with him and never hit me or scolded me, so he thought my temperament was better and that by living with me he could enjoy his blessings, so he stayed with me, and my father had a retirement salary at the time.

So didn't you tell me before that you were miserable as a child? You also have to do any crafts by yourself to support yourself.

My father then my mother was sick, my father came home to take care of my mother's, then work on the interval of two years, the interval of two years, then that kind of era and

do not allow you to do business ah sell things ah what.

My father, he is very business minded, he can sell a lot of things, he is very handy, also can make clothes ah what, he will, but that era does not allow him to do this, do not allow him to do this, he will hide everywhere, because there is no work, so I am also quite hard to go to school when my grades are also very good, that is, the night homework never bring home to do. Because bring it home I don't have the time and I have to craft and make money doing crafts myself.

Well, couldn't you guys say in those days that you could not make crafts to go out and sell? How do you pay back?

That uh as long as you don't buy sell we are own uh get that grass rolled into a rope, hand rolled into a rope, rolled into a rope, and then tie that rope bag, sell to the people in the countryside, the farmers to hold cotton, load cotton ah what, that's not called speculation. That's not speculation, because you take the grass yourself from the roadside.

That is, you buy things to sell things, for example, you buy pork, ah trafficking pork ah or trafficking something to sell, that is said to be speculation, that era is not allowed.

At that time, you were also considered well-off.

We were quite well off in the city, both of us had jobs, we only had one son, and my father had a job and a pension, so we were doing quite well.

So did you stay with your grandfather because he had a steady job? And then were there any other qualities that attracted you to Grandpa?

No, not really. Because Grandpa had always worked on the street, he came to our house and stayed in our house, and we were attracted to each other for a long time because he was in my class and he lived on the same street. Your grandfather went to school with good grades, well then also see him loyal and honest.

Why didn't he go to college? Didn't he get good grades? Because he couldn't go to university at that time?

He later Zhiqing back to the city, he is Zhiqing, I do not qualify for college, I did not go to the countryside to exercise, he exercised can go to college but at that time our family already have a son, but he could not let me, he said a person at home, he did not go to college, in fact, he could go to college, he exams can also be admitted.

And then after that um you guys lived at your dad's house and grandad lived in his own big family?What's the point of mentioning them?

They lived together. There were six sisters in the family,

and Grandpa was the oldest.

Grandpa lived with his family all the time. How strange is that?

We had a custom that a boy had to be raised in a house, so where would a girl live if she didn't have a house when she got married?

What?

His mother was a snob and wouldn't build us a house, so we had no choice but to live in my father's house.

They didn't give us a house, so we stayed at my father's house, and we were self-reliant, a family of three, and we were very frugal. And then when my son was three years old, we built a big house.

When he was three years old, you were only working for a few years and you already had a big house?

Well, I had saved up a little bit of money, and after a few years of work, my father supported us with 1/3 of the money.

And then um actually you don't have much contact with Grandpa on their side of the family.

I don't live with him so much.

Then why did you say something to me before? That old lady of theirs bullies you?

I don't want to answer that question. Why not? I'm not

happy to answer that question.

I'm not happy to answer that question, I don't want to I don't want to have any kinship with their family.

In fact, I just want to ask you why you hate the old lady so much? Why do you hate the old lady so much? Is it good?

The relationship between the old lady and you is equivalent to the relationship between my mother and you, equivalent to him being your mother-in-law?

Yeah. - Yeah.

So why is your mother-in-law not nice to you, I've always wondered?

I am so nice to her, she is not even nice to me.

Why don't you treat us well, he that talk their family don't count, I don't want to talk about this thing, I say this thing I pain, I don't want to talk about this thing.

In the past, when I was working, I didn't mess with her, but she came to the door of my factory and slept there to ruin my reputation.

My father-in-law, that is, his father is quite good to me, but he that financial does not make the decision, not a penny support for our family.

Well, it is because the old lady is not good to you, so in fact you and their family did not say much.

I can't say anything about their family, they're all so

strong and ruthless. I'm telling you I spent so much money raising my son, treating him so well, and bringing you up hard. The most that time is your father, they blindly scolded me, our house all the things to hold threw up, the dinner table are lifted up.

I want to know why they were like that. Why are they like this?

Is it because their family is poor?

They're not poor, but they're a tough family. They're all tough.

Their family is not like my father, my father, he has a good brain and he is hardworking, my father is retired, he still does many things, he has many side businesses, he goes to get nets to get fish nets shrimps and so on, he gets other people's pigs and he kills them, ah he he is very hardworking, he is very smart. My father was very smart.

I was on the street at that time, your grandfather's household registration was from the countryside, and at that time it was impossible for me to give it to him, it was impossible to marry him, it was impossible to marry him, because he was from the countryside. Later on, he was always in our place, always in our place is also also even, these two people is better. But that was the year of the

Zhiqing it is three Zhiqing, the family has three adult Zhiqing can be on the street, one, draw a street. At that time, his brother went to join the army, it is impossible to draw his brother, but it is his son and daughter two people, because her daughter is a primary school graduate, and has married someone else.

She was married to Zhu Aifu, a man from the countryside. She is the account in this side, is supposed to be your grandfather on the street, but his mother is more barbaric, listened to his eldest daughter's she wants to go on the street, is your grandfather Zhang Yongsheng's father, he said it is impossible to give her on the street.

For one thing, she graduated from primary school and didn't have that to go out on the street.

Secondly, my daughter-in-law's account is on the street.

He gave the account to your grandfather, and then your grandfather went to the hospital.

For this matter, his eldest daughter was brutal, and her mother followed her, and after that, it was out of control, as if she had planted the seeds of hatred in me.

When I had the baby. I did not have a mother, she did not even wash a nappy for me, cook a meal for me to eat. At that time, my lover was not at home yet, still working in Grass Temple, ninety miles away from my place.

So in the future, no matter how nice you are to her, because Zhang Yongsheng's father was quite nice, so we still have to do our filial duty, don't we? We'll send him things for New Year's Eve, Mid-Autumn Festival and so on. But no matter what you do to him, he acts like you're an enemy. He didn't take my son for a day or an hour. My son was 4 years old and in kindergarten. He was hungry and when he came back, he was at the paste shop and asked for a cake. He said he didn't know my son, I don't know you. He didn't even buy a cake for my son to eat, so in his case, his conflict went more and more, I can't ignore her.

Because I can't argue with them, they have too many family members. So later on, when my son got a little bit older, I bought them everything, and I told him that my son would have a midday meal at their house because I was on a business trip and wouldn't be back until the afternoon. When my son came back in the afternoon, he hadn't eaten yet, I asked him why he didn't eat, why he didn't make rice for the baby to eat, I said I bought 5kg of meat for you guys only last time, that means the baby will have a meal at your place while I'm on a business trip, and he said I hadn't eaten it yet, what will he eat, and that's what a grandma does to her grandchildren.

My husband, he is more that, he does not take anything from

his unit home to give them. Sometimes his friends, we went to his friends to play, their friends have anything to say, your family also have, I know he did not take things home to give my youngest son to eat, he gave them to eat.

Grandpa has always been quite filial. Filial piety. He's the filial piety of that. He's monstrously filial. It's not like they don't have jobs, and we were quite filial when Zhang Yongsheng's dad died. His grandfather was in that hospital for two months and two days, and it was Zhang Yongsheng and I who served him. They didn't even go, and his wife didn't even go to see him on the road from Xinfeng to Dafeng for two months and two days.

People say I'm filial, their neighbours say I'm filial, she says I'm not filial, my father-in-law says I'm filial, my father-in-law died, my father-in-law died when my son was 10 years old, laid out in the house, but also I got him to the People's Hospital to see, get late, he was sick, he wanted to shout us, his wife did not shout at us, do not shout at us to delay the disease down, delayed down to the People's Hospital, because I that brother I found a person who said that your father-in-law would die if he didn't go beyond 12 o'clock at night, and I didn't believe him at all. I also fed him bananas in the afternoon, and he ate half a banana, so after my father-in-law died, their family

had the money not to take a penny out of the use, I went home to take 5,000 yuan at that time, 5,000 yuan out of the burial of his father, because his father used to be a cadre, and can not leave it at home, to be laughed at by others.

I don't talk to them, your grandpa is also unreasonable, and his mother a moral, so I sometimes grandma has to video with you.

Sometimes grandma is scolded by him for everything, no matter how many people he is in front of, he is the same as his mother, there is no affection at all, so I'm with your grandpa, you can see that we both sleep in our own rooms, and it doesn't have anything to do with him at all.

Grandpa loves you, but he has to be filial to his mother?

It's none of my business. He does his duty, and I do mine. When he was sick, he wasn't in our house, they didn't know she was sick, I said I'd wash her bum, I said I'd wash it with you, I washed it for her, she was embarrassed to say it was wet, then I changed it for her, washed it for her when she was asleep at night, he didn't know his mum was paralysed on the floor, it was all because I'd picked her up to do the washing up, I'd washed her clothes for 16 days, that's why I'd said that about them on that website. I'm quite filial, that grandfather in Dafeng hospitalised

two months and two days, I used a bicycle ah rode the Zhangqi sat in front, sat in that he did not take an hour with us with the child, we Zhangqi ah he did not give us an hour with the child ah. Not you guys now ah yo watch a film, Zhang Jiale sent you there.

I'm quite happy, ah Zhang Jiale happened to come to me accustomed to. They said we go to the cinema also give the child to bring her, our children do not want her, our family Zhang Qi see them just like a stranger crying, he does not want her.

So my dad was brought up by you and his grandpa, your dad, and grandpa, who basically worked, and the three of you.

That's when you worked in the factory, first as an accountant, then as a factory manager, then as a street office director. Was that all because you wanted to do that? Or was it just assigned to you?

This is to be an accountant, as long as you are skilled in business and responsible for your work. I was responsible for my work when I came to work, so you can always do it. Well that work began when I was doing accounting, do decades of accounting, and then went to the town audit office to do the audit work, audit work, then later is the reform and opening up, some factories are contracted to individuals, contracted to individuals, then he this town

he wants to see a few female cadres typical, well then I was assigned to the standard parts factory to do the factory director, do the factory director to do the live more than a year, a year later I ah I don't want to do the job. After more than one year, I ah do not want to do the factory director, so I asked the leadership with me, because I do accounting do decades used to do the factory director he has to be alone, and then contracted, uh, anyway, the work of the heavy burden is also quite heavy, I asked the town cadres to give me to give me to re-transfer a job, that the town cadres said that you can write an article ah to write anything, so I was transferred to the street office as a deputy director of the, uh, mainly to catch the The main focus was on police work.

So actually all these jobs were assigned at the beginning and then you didn't want to work in the factory because you felt that you felt that the factory director didn't quite fit your character.

Right.

Do you work hard every day?

Every day work can be, I do accounting time is very easy, because I that business skilled, that do factory manager well always have to socialise, ah to night sometimes people come, to socialise ah people customers, over ah have to

accompany people drink ah what, this I am not very adaptable. The reason for requesting a transfer of work is that at night my family lives in Dafeng, away from this Xinfeng there are more than ten miles of road, then the traffic is not so convenient, not to say that you can play, say that that can be that, so it is very inconvenient. It's just that if it's late at night, this is inconvenient.

You were in your 40s then?

I was in my 40s, 4050 or so.

Then you later street office is Dafeng?

It was Xinfeng, but that one was different, not on the night shift. Well that was in the street office, and when I got to the street office, my son had already graduated from college, and he settled in Xinfeng after he graduated from college. He's in Xinfeng, his school is in Xinfeng, I'm in Xinfeng, I live in Xinfeng, we bought my son a wedding house, in Xinfeng, a new three-room apartment.

So you live with mum and dad?

Our family lives in Xinfeng. Grandpa also lives in Xinfeng. At that time, we rented out this house to other people. Dafeng's house was rented out to other people.

So your job was assigned at first, but you could choose it yourself later?

No, I didn't. They had to be assigned. It's all decided by

the Party Committee. It's not just a matter of what you want to do, but also according to your ability to work, according to your ability to adapt, he will transfer you to a new job.

Well, you then retired, is this 40 or 50 years old have my time.

I retired when I was 49, 49, actual age 48, I retired.

So why did you choose to retire so early?

Because that daughter-in-law of mine said that children can not be given to others to bring up, they bring up irresponsible, not good for the growth of children, so she asked me to retire early, because my husband he can not retire, he is the state of the country bit, he is a hospital. He can't retire until then. That's when I sacrificed for the family.

Then my mum didn't have time to bring me up at that time because she was very busy at work, right?

Your mum didn't have much time to take care of you either, you slept with me since you were born, you didn't sleep with your mum, I took care of you. I lived with your mum for two years before I brought you to Dafeng.

That's after I started kindergarten I was in Dafeng?

It was before you even started kindergarten. It was when you were two weeks old that we brought you to Dafeng, and

because there were fewer kids here, we sent you to a small class.

It feels like you had to bring up dad again since you were a child, and then work for so many years, work for the country for so many years, and then there is no saying that you go to do one of what you like, and then you go to bring me up again, do you feel sorry for that it's like this has always been just a lot of hard work.

I don't have any regrets, I work for the peace of my family and for their peace of mind.

Did my mum not want to bring me up?

No, she didn't. It's not that your mum didn't want to take you. Your mum worked at school and sometimes she took you during the day. At night, I took the baby with me so that they could sleep and work at ease. Because I like children very much, so I brought it with me, and after I brought it with me, he had to go to kindergarten, so we brought it to Dafeng. Because the conditions in Dafeng is a little bit better than Xinfeng, the baby goes to school, because we live in Dafeng, only a few hundred metres away from the experimental primary school, only a few hundred metres away. So we came here. At that time, Dafeng Experimental Primary School was also the best primary school in Dafeng, and the kindergarten was also very good, so we brought the

baby to Dafeng.

At that time I remember you were in poor health, when I was little there was a time when you slept at noon you fell asleep asleep, then I shouted at you and you didn't wake up, that time do you still remember?

At that time you were already 8 years old, when you were 8 years old, I had a serious illness, that is, bad heart, people's doctors said that I don't have much time to live, can only eat and play, can't bring up children.

So Grandma did you inherit your heart disease or did you just have it since you were a child?

There are many reasons for heart disease, not just hereditary, and heredity has a part to play in it, but sometimes it's also depressing. I was alone at home for a long time, so I got a heart attack.

Did you get it in your 30s?

I was in my 50s. At 57, you were already 8 years old.

That's when you had the heart attack. There were no signs before? There were no signs, no? I had a heart attack too. You didn't have a heart attack. How did you find out you had a heart attack?

That can't breathe, can't breathe. Lips are purple, can't hold things, a few pounds to carry on the body can't hold, so go to the hospital to check it, after checking it.

I just remember that time you scared me to death. That was the time you had a heart attack.

At that time in the Begonia Garden you do not go to school, but also is not issued once, collapsed next to you you scared to death.

Then you've been worried about my school life?

It's all for your future.

Why do you always just for me to live? Why do you always care about my things, our family's things, and seldom care about your own likes and dislikes? I've always been especially curious to ask.

Because I love my son too much. Too that spoil him, so now he is not so too that too good, speak ah what, to me also not too that. Because I'm more affectionate. Because of my father, when I was small, I did not have a mother, my father did not scold me, did not beat me. He has always been very good to me, so it may also be hereditary, a heart for the children.

Then why is it that after giving birth to me, which is already equivalent to being your granddaughter, it's a lifetime ago that you're still so good to me?

After a generation, we want their young people to work well and live a good life, so we are relieved. I'd like to work a little harder myself and help with the kids. But children

are a comfort to me, because I love them. Every move they make. Yes, I do. I love children.

Why do you make so much money and then give it all to your children and your grandchildren? And yet you live in this shabby second-floor house with all the old fittings.

Our house is quite good, we have lived for decades, as the saying goes, "A golden house and a silver house is not as good as one's own grass nest, this is quite good to live here, your grandpa is too annoying, he is not willing to live with you, but I want to ask him to live with me, but he refused to refuse, even if it is not. He's over 70 years old, and I'm over 70 years old, and no one can change anything.

The society is developing so fast and the conditions are so good.

The first floor was quite nice, and as long as I cleaned up the house, it was fresh and clean, and when people came to our house, they said our house was quite clean.

I didn't have a childcare centre in the factory at that time. Your grandfather worked 90 miles away from me, and the transport was not convenient at that time, so he took a single day off a week, and he came back only one day a week. I was alone with a child, his body is not good, I was thin only 90 pounds, the wind blew people have given me a

name called the ribs, the wind can be blown down, often feverish, but also every morning when I go to work with my son, big and raised and chubby every day to go to work on his back, the place where I work from me is also more than a mile away nearly two miles, I carry him every day to go back to his back. I carried him to work and back home every day. Your father is also worried, your father naughty, do homework what is not serious, but we are minded only want to train them, such as teachers ah doctors ah, just want them to have a future, people like them like junior high school graduation out of work, people say we are really stupid, said he graduated from that can get more than 300 yuan salary, at that time, I said no, I said I'm going to let him go to college, all day long, and his Greedy to play, not to play games, people run into the people ran into my place that he played games, because he that play games too skilled, people buy a penny that stuffed, people play a few times on no, he can play until noon, so people a game machine people are making money, the boss saw him go yet to sit down and can not not sell him, yet to sit down, the people to my factory shouted, you! My son went to play games again, I went to get him home again.

I'm going to get him home again. You're not just bringing up the kids, you're bringing up my dad, and you're bringing

up me. So do you actually have any hobbies apart from spending time with us? Because I see that you're always meddling in our family's affairs, and I feel that you should cultivate your own hobbies and do something instead of worrying about our affairs all the time. You haven't thought about it?

I've thought about it. They shouted at me that I could go to Guandan Card Game with them this afternoon, and it would be fun to talk to their old friends, and my friends are quite nice, and they're quite nice to me, and I'm quite nice to them. But they are just playing with themselves. They went to work, like this afternoon I, I'm not like in this hot pot of ants, ah and have to deal with you and have to deal with him ah

Then you usually Monday to Friday Zhang Jiale go to school, I'm in Nanjing, well then you can play by yourself.

Oh before when I can not afford to Zhang Jiale basketball home, they come home and then cook for Zhang Jiale to eat, Zhang Jiale like a hungry wolf looking for food, eat biscuits to eat what? When she cooks, Zhang Jiale has already eaten almost, so Zhang Jiale's health is not good, the resistance is poor, so I can't afford to buy some food in the afternoon, go to their home, burned for Zhang Jiale to eat a little bit of hard work, I have that vertigo,

heart disease, they do not allow me to ride a battery car, I go out to the public transport, running back and forth. It's very hard for me, but I can't bear to let go of Zhang Jiale. I cook for him a few times a week.

You see, there are six of us in our family now, do you feel happy?

"Why not happy? I have grandchildren again, I'm so happy and joyful, oh I'm willing to do it more often, but I'm not willing to do it, and they don't force me to do it, I do it of my own free will."

Alas grandma I now hope that you can make yourself more happy, do a little bit of their own happy things, ah play with friends, do do a little bit of your own hobbies, you you also do not go always go to care about the things in our family, because you worry about ah their own difficult, and mum and dad will also be too much for you to be annoyed, and it is right, right?

"Pay back more than 100,000 interest a year, Grandma does not worry ah? Grandma's not worried? They pay back so fast ah, grandpa willing to take out hundreds of thousands of let them pay off the debt ah, you that last year in Beijing, we went to 30,000, this year went to 90,000, 120,000, immediately learn English, another 20,000, I also want to not worry about. "

I also want not to worry, I also want no one to come to me. But then you say you stay with us, you feel that your family is important to you, and you're happy and unhappy? Ah I'm happy I'm happy. I'm happy. I'm happy when you learn more. I'm happy when you guys are good.

Well, if, for example, a person could be reincarnated and start all over again, would you still choose to live like this?

"I would still choose to live like this. I'm happy."

Would you still choose to just do whatever it takes to bring us up?

"I'd do it as long as I could I would. Getting the family going, making the family more peaceful, I'm willing to do it as long as I have the strength to do it, as long as I don't get sick."

So over the years it just feels like you've had so many things in your life from when you were young to now having children and then children and then children and so many things, have you had a lot of times where you've had regrets about things?

I have no regrets.

But you see you actually people in your time were not like us now have so many choices, you see I can still choose art, choose to paint, mum and dad it choose to go to teach

ah or what, for example, dad every day to play mahjong, he has his own hobbies, then why would you not be a little bit of selfish it, just a little bit of selfishness to do it. There are also a lot of old people who are not like you, they also have their own ideas, you must also have this kind of people around.

Some people every day to go to square dancing ah to play ah to travel ah. I am what money are used on you, what force are used on you. I haven't bought clothes for a few years, but I bought a lot of clothes when I was young, and I like to wear clothes.

Why don't you spend your money now on buying lots of nice clothes and going out to eat something nice and travelling with your friends?

Eat quite well. Eat I can cook all kinds of dishes by myself I can cook, well what dishes to mix what what dishes with what I can cook, I cook quite well. I don't want to go to a restaurant, you can't eat the food in the restaurant too often, he puts too much MSG in it, I eat it and go home, I go to someone else's banquet and go home thirsty, so I don't want to eat it, I cook my own food is quite good, the food I cooked today, look at the yam, is it good? And the celery, and the red pepper, you can see that it has all the colours and flavours. I have a lot of clothes, I

have a lot of clothes, I have a lot of clothes, I used to buy clothes in the autumn and then buy, summer clothes in the autumn and then buy, after buying it to keep the next year to wear, that is good-looking and affordable, people only half price, like my mink jacket people started to New Year's Eve when they sold 2,500, I went to the summer to buy in June, they gave me, because I am his regular customer, he only gave me 1,000 yuan. I was a regular customer and he only gave me 1000 yuan and I took it home.

Don't you want to go travelling like your friends?

Travelling I can't run much right now, I just don't have a good heart. And then there's travelling. It's time-consuming. I don't like to run much, and travelling, I also played a lot of places, you see I also went to Beijing a few times, took the plane five times. This Heilongjiang, Harbin I also went.
