  - Eileen's Cookies, lemonade and tea will be served.
- **5<sup>th</sup> Grade Celebration - May 10<sup>th</sup> (no music this day)**
  - Sydnee reaching out to the 5<sup>th</sup> grade parents to form a committee
  - 18 students
  - \$275-300 budget for this event
- **Field Day - May 17<sup>th</sup> in the afternoon**
  - Discussed potted plants from last year and paint.

- o Suggestion to do markers instead of paint. Looking into a canvas bag to decorate. Could look at Oriental Trading. Reviewing budget for Field Day.
- o Suggestion of a craft bag/zipper bag.
- **GCO Scholarship**
  - o Students have to have their scholarship applications filled out by March 18<sup>th</sup>.
  - o Mrs. Schall will send online form to the group to complete. Due April 8<sup>th</sup>.
  - o At this point only open to students still in Kearney. This was decided last year.

  - o She will get the coffee
  - o Sending a Facebook message and Sign Up Genius for breakfast, lunch and snacks.
  - o This will replace the conference meals that we didn't do because of Zoom.
- **Spring BBQ - April 28<sup>th</sup>**
  - o We still need someone to head this event up.
  - o Sydnee will keep putting out to Facebook and in Sunday message.
  - o Banzhaf family will donate hamburger.
  - o Jamie reaching out to Jacee Pohl to see if Trius would be interested in donating hot dogs.

### **Principal Report**

- Mrs. Schall discussed the playground equipment project.
- We had to go with a different vendor due to a legal situation with the first company.
- Two items have been bid. They would provide two different experiences for the students.
- One piece will fit well where the old swing set is.
- 6-10 feet tall - mini half dome.
- Inclusive - wheelchair height and 6 students can play on it at a time.
- The two pieces together total \$11,305 with \$3,000 installation - total needed \$14, 805.
- If ordered soon - it will take 12-15 weeks to get it here and installed by August 2022.
- Class Act & Give Where You Live funds will pay for half of the total and request that GCO pay for the other half.
- Motion to purchase the two pieces suggested by Mrs. Schall and for GCO to pay for half of the playground equipment. MSC (Jamie/Krisa)
- Snack Sale March 10<sup>th</sup>
- Report Cards March 25<sup>th</sup>
- March 21-May 6 - Maps, Fast Bridge and State testing.
- Spring Activities - Sunrise Orchestra, 5<sup>th</sup> grade visits Sunrise, various field trips
- Book fair had another great turnout.
- Food Drive provided record breaking donations.
