Discover Bolivia: Exploring Land, Culture, and Community

March 13-23, 2026

Experience Bolivia in March 2026! Join the Edina Rotary Global Scholars to explore Bolivia's landscapes and vibrant communities while engaging in cultural exchange, service, and environmental learning. Open to EHS students in grades 9-12 (with priority given to Global Scholars), this 10-day trip is led by Lindsey Smaka in collaboration with Kagumu Adventures.





Highlights include:

- Cultural Exploration: Homestays with Quechua families, traditional dance, weaving, and music.
- Global Collaboration: Exchange with local Bolivian youth groups.
- Service & Sustainability: Water ecosystem restoration, farming, canoe building, rainforest conservation.
- Environmental Insights: Witness flamingos, trek the Amazon, and explore salt flats.
- Adventure: La Paz cable cars, Uyuni Salt Flats, Amazon hike, and Andean rituals.

This expedition combines learning, service, and adventure, offering a unique opportunity to immerse yourself in Bolivia's culture and spirit while giving back to the community. Join us to make a difference and expand your worldview!

Cost Information

- Total Cost: Approximately \$4,500, which includes flights, meals, activities and accommodations.
- **Payment Plan:** After a \$1,000 deposit, the remaining amount will be divided into three-part payments.
- **Financial Assistance:** Need-based & merit-based grants, as well as active fundraising opportunities, are available to help offset costs.
