Depth of Reflection & Engagement with Questions	Demonstrates a thorough and insightful reflection that fully engages with one or more of the provided questions. Clear use of specific examples or personal experiences to support the reflection.	Provides a solid reflection that addresses one of the questions, with some engagement and examples, though depth may be limited in parts.	Offers a brief or superficial reflection that lacks depth, examples, or personal insight. Minimal engagement with the questions.
Clarity of Writing	Writing is clear, concise, and well-organized. The paragraph flows logically, with no major grammatical errors.	Writing is mostly clear but may have minor issues with organization or grammar that slightly affect readability.	Writing is disorganized, unclear, or contains significant grammatical errors, making it hard to follow.
Adherence to Length Requirement	Reflection is within the specified length (100–150 words), demonstrating the ability to write concisely without losing depth.	Slightly over or under the word limit, but still provides a mostly complete reflection.	Significantly over or under the word limit, affecting the depth and completeness of the reflection.
