



mRelief is a tech non-profit that connects low-income Americans to SNAP (food stamps) and we have a new volunteer opportunity to help with outreach. We are seeking volunteers to complete applications for SNAP over the phone with eligible applicants. About half of our outreach list will be <u>college students</u>, 48% of whom nationwide experienced food insecurity in the past 30 days. Volunteers will have a direct impact connecting people to the benefits they need - an average of \$150 per month to buy food.
