Project Asistensya Launching
January 14, 2022

The Supreme Student Government has recently launched one of the long-term projects proposed for this academic year entitled Project Asistensya last January 14, 2022, which was done via Facebook live. The project launching includes the overview of the proposed measures, methods of implementation as well the timeline and its entirety that gives information to the target clientele, students. On the conclusion of the project launching, it was held successfully which at this point the council is expecting for its further implementation.

Starting from the planning of the launching, project proponents held a meeting with the SSG President on January 6. The topic of discussion in the meeting includes the assignment of the tasks that needs to be done and the things that the proponents need to prepare. The meeting lasted for about an hour of which resulted to a productive output. The meeting was also utilized to brainstorm and plan for the execution of the launching to make it appealing and decent to the audience's eyes. The Project Heads and the facilitators of this project are only given a week to prepare and do their assigned tasks.

The Preparation of this Project Asistensya Launching includes the preparation of the video presentation, and the Powerpoint Presentation (this is for the meeting with the GLO, and Clubs Presidents.). The project heads are asked to prepare and need to take an audio clip for their assigned part, the launching is divided into several parts, so they also need to send several audio clips and they needed to send it to the group chat for the editor to edit and compile the audio clips. Sadly speaking, some of the officers can't send audio clips because of some technical problems, and the background noise that their audio has, but even we experienced that unexpected situation, officers substituted to the assigned role to suffice the remaining requirements for the implementation. In the live launching preparation, the Grade 10 Representatives entirely edited and prepared the video presentation, and some of them even prepare and helped to make audio clips that will be used in the video presentation.

During the live launching the program started with the activity preliminaries including the national anthem and a prayer which was led by Grade 9 Representative Malko Peñaflor which is also one of the project heads. Followed by the opening remarks given by Grade 9 Representative, Carlo Pastor. On the opening remarks, it was highlighted that the project asistensya is aimed to be an aid for the students in the context of online and modular learning difficulties since its implementation last academic year. The remarks also included the encouragement of all Hayskulanos to actively participate in the venture to mend and be a bridge thereof to our fellow school mates. Afterwards, the project presentation was held. This included the 10-minute presentation of the project itself. An introductory was given to give light to students what are the root causes of the project implementation. Following, the extensive explanation of the sub-projects under this program which includes Share-A-Note, student assistance, book drive, hayskulano community drive, and E-tukdo. Process of implementation was discussed thoroughly in the presentation to be easily understood by the students and for the project to be entertained. A short intermission number was also given by Grade 8 student Charmelle Badiola to light up the ambiance of the project launching. Closing the program, the



project heads and the working committees was introduced before the student-body. This enables the students to know who the people behind the implemented project are.

To wrap up, the project launching is successful. The final video presentation is very neat and appealing to the audience and its content includes salient points and information that may help the other student to understand and realize what this Project Asistensya is all about. 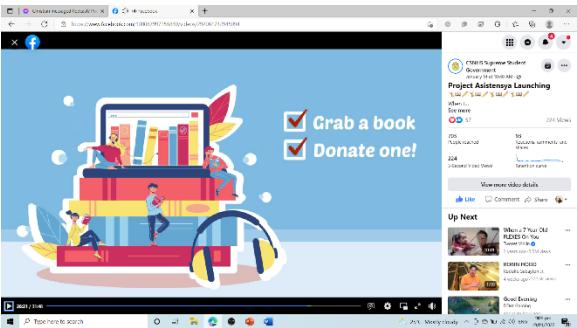
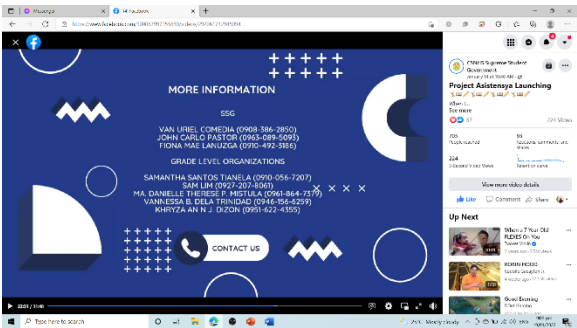
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
