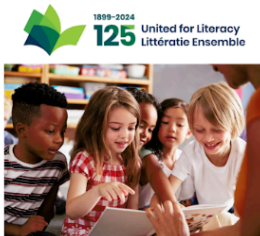
Does your child need homework help?
