

Privacy Policy—StickersCraft: Launcher

Your privacy is important to us.

We are committed to protecting the privacy of our users ("users" or "you"). This Privacy Policy (the "Policy") explains our practices for collecting, storing, using, managing, and protecting your user information (including personal information) when you use our application and all its features (the "Services"), where we act as the data controller.

Please note that this Policy only applies to user information (including personal information) collected or received by WASTicker Studio during your use of the Services. In this Policy, "personal information" refers to any information or combination of information that can be used to identify, contact, or locate the individual to whom the collected information relates. Such personal information may include your email address, images, and more.

1. Log Data

We want to inform you that whenever you use our Service, if an error occurs in the app, we will collect data and information (via third-party products) from your device, which is referred to as Log Data. This Log Data may include your device's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, device name, operating system version, the app's configuration when using our Service, the time and date of your Service use, and other statistical information.

2. Device Information

We collect information about your device, including the hardware model, operating system and its version, unique device identifiers (such as SSAID and GAID), browser type and language, mobile device phone number, mobile network information, International Mobile Equipment Identity ("IMEI"), Identifier for Advertising ("IDFA"), Identifier for Vendor ("IDFV"), Integrated Circuit Card Identifier ("ICCID"), Media Access Control ("MAC") address, device model, and screen resolution.

We use this information to calculate the number of devices using our products and Services, and to analyze data related to device models and graphics adaptation. You may choose not to provide certain information, but this may prevent you from using many features of our APP. We also collect specific device information to help

diagnose issues (in the rare event that you encounter crashes or other problems) while using our Services.

3. Camera and Photos

Many of our Services require us to collect images and other information from your device's camera and photo library. We will only access your camera and photos after you give your consent. You may choose not to provide this access, but this may prevent you from using many of our Services.

4. Local Storage

We may collect and store information locally on your device using methods such as browser web storage (including HTML 5) and application data caches. The information we store locally will not be shared with any third parties.

5. Non-Personal Information

Non-personal information refers to data that cannot be directly associated with any specific individual. Examples include your Android ID, CPN model, memory size, device IMEI number, phone model, ROM, names and package names of installed applications, mobile operator, location, installation and uninstallation records, and usage frequency.

We may collect and use non-personal information in the following scenarios: To better understand user behavior, resolve issues with our products and services, and improve our products, services, and advertising, we may collect non-personal information such as the names and package names of installed applications, installation data, usage frequency, country, device information, and channel information.
