# <u>Project Based Learning</u> <u>Create a Model of the Layers of the Earth!</u>

## Due: Friday, February 21st

Create a model of the Earth's structure explaining the nature of each of the Earth's layers. In your model, you must show the Earth's **crust**, the **mantle**, the **outer core**, and **inner core**.

Use your notes and independent research to help you understand the nature of the layers of the Earth before you begin your project.

# **Guidelines:**

## You need:

- ☐ A model
- An explanation of the model and of each layer
  - ☐ Labels (Inner Core, Outer Core, Mantle, Crust)
  - ☐ Phase of matter (solid or liquid, or molten rock for the mantle)
  - □ Temperature
  - ☐ An attempt to scale the depth of the layers. (The crust should be very thin)

What students have done in the past:

#### **Edible Earth**

Create an edible Earth that shows the layers of the Earth. <u>Label</u> each layer. On this label, explain how each of your edible layers shows what that layer of the earth is like. Explain what that layer of the Earth is really made of, and what why you chose that particular food to represent it. Example: The dense inner core could be represented by a hard candy. (Many models of this can be found online!)

#### 3 – D Model

You can create this out of clay, a Styrofoam ball (directions found at <a href="http://www.ehow.com/how\_4495708\_make-model-earth\_s-layers.html">http://www.ehow.com/how\_4495708\_make-model-earth\_s-layers.html</a>), or any other medium you see fit! Maybe you could find something in nature to represent it!

**Label** each layer. On this label, explain how each of your layers shows what that layer of the earth is like. Explain what that layer of the Earth is really made of, and what why you chose that particular material or color to represent it.
