BASKETBALL PRACTICES ARE STARTING this Sunday, October 29th, for boys and girls in grades 3-8, who signed up to play for the Holy Cross Grade School Basketball teams. All players should have already been given the Practice Schedule and extra copies are available in the school office. If you signed up to play basketball, but have decided not to play now, please stop by the office today and let us know.

PRACTICES WILL BE HELD IN THE HOLY CROSS GYM except for the 7th & 8th grade boys team which will be practicing at Holy Family and the 6th grade boys team will practice at Holy Family sometimes. ALL PLAYERS ARE TO ENTER AND EXIT THE **HOLY CROSS GYM** THROUGH THE GYM DOORS NEAREST THE RAILROAD TRACKS. DO NOT ENTER OR EXIT THROUGH THE LOBBY DOORS. Absolutely NO FOOD, DRINKS or CHEWING GUM are permitted in the Gym area. Players should not arrive at practices any earlier than 10 minutes before their practices begin because it is too disruptive to the teams practicing. Upon arrival, players should sit quietly in the bleachers and wait for their practice to begin. Coaches will be at the doors to let in their players and to monitor them. Players should carry their basketball shoes into the gym and change them inside the gym. No street shoes should be worn onto the gym floor.
