Claims and Receipts

Review and Ratify Actions Taken – Natural Disaster Response

Pursuant to the resolution the Board approved on September 30, 2024, Ms. Current presented the Board with more items approved by the insurance adjuster and asked for Board action to approve pursuant to Paragraph 4 of the resolution. Mr. Phillips made the motion to approve the payment and Mr. Towell seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

Donations

The Jr-Sr High School received several donations. The show choir received \$3,000 from the Jay County Visitors and Tourism Bureau and \$1,000 from Compass Poultry to be used for transportation costs, entry fees, props, music, and costumes. The high school boys' basketball team received a donation of \$7,800 from a golf outing held by Friends of Jay County Basketball which will be used for equipment, clothing and gear. Jay County Robotics received \$3,000 from The Portland Foundation for new field and game elements. Mr. Clark made the motion to approve the generous donations and Ms. Vormohr seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

Permission to Sell Surplus Items

Ms. Vormohr made the motion to approve the sale of two spare buses that are no longer in use through an online auction using Bricker Auction Company. This online auction would begin in October or November. Mr. Phillips seconded and the motion passed 5-0.

ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Formative Assessment Grant

Mr. Towell made the motion to accept the Formative Assessment Grant in the amount of \$21,523.14 for the use in helping to purchase NWEA. NWEA is an assessment administered to the students on three separate occasions during the school year. Mr. Clark seconded and the motion passed 5-0.
