- Canvas Commons is a new feature that is embedded in our Canvas Learning
 Management System. Commons is available to instructors only and allows
 sharing of course resources like files, images, quizzes and modules (and even
 entire courses!), from course to course and even from institution to
 institution.
- Instructors can put course materials into Canvas and share them within their department, Keene State College as a whole, or even with all Canvas users at all Canvas schools worldwide!
- When uploading materials to share, instructors can choose the license that is appropriate, add search terms, and direct it to the most appropriate audience.
- With Commons you can:
 - create a personal learning object repository
 - Build a course from scratch (or update your current courses) with relevant materials shared by other Canvas users
 - Create a name for yourself and your institution as a subject matter expert
