

Jason left his Texas State University apartment at 10:55pm on Sunday 12/13/2020. He was going home to his Sienna home in Missouri City, Texas. At 11:24 pm, Jason entered the city of Luling and stopped using Waze. When he reached the intersection of Magnolia and Austin streets, it appears he continued straight instead of turning right towards I-10 which would have been his way home. He continued about 5 miles on a mostly narrow, gravel road. For some reason his car spun out and hit a tree and barbed wire fence making his car undriveable. His car was found by a young volunteer fireman at 12:31 am. Jason's keys were in the ignition and the car headlights were still shining. A state trooper arrived at 1:17am. The clear evening was extra cold with arctic winds. The shoes and clothes Jason was wearing, his backpack, his toiletries, and his fish in a tumbler were all in the street. His phone was left in his car. Jason was nowhere to be found. Jason's dad, Kent, drove to Luling during the night. The next day, Texas Search and Rescue was called to search for Jason. Many, many searches and investigations have been done. What happened in those 67 minutes?
