Application for Trusted Medic Status

INTRODUCTION

This application outline is for those who wish to become Trusted Medics for the [Reddit Rescue Force](#). Trusted Medics are marked as such with a cross icon on both the subreddit and the TeamSpeak server. This gives patients a general assurance that the person helping them is not an ambusher or bandit.

If you intend to submit an application, make sure to fulfill **ALL** the requirements that are laid out in this document before contacting the moderators.

The information in this document is subject to change without notice.

RESCUE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Provide a detailed record of each rescue that you performed. Create a Microsoft Word, Google Doc, or any equivalent method to keep track of your progress.

For each rescue entry, the original poster (of the rescue request) **MUST** comment back on the original thread with the **names of the medics** who saved them. If this is not present, that specific rescue entry is not valid until the original poster acknowledges that you saved them. If the patient does not credit the medics within 10 minutes of a rescue being completed, the **medics must contact a TeamSpeak admin immediately**.

In your list of rescues, save the links to each of these posts so that we have actual proof that you completed the rescue missions. Starvation rescues only count toward TMI status. The required number of rescued entries is a **minimum of fifteen (15)**. If you have more successful rescues, please add them as well.

Conditions

No more than **five (5) overwatch** credited rescues may count toward this number.

No more than **three (3) mercy-kill** credited rescues may count toward this number.

RESCUE APPLICATION FORMAT

There are two accepted ways for the application to be formatted. The accepted formats for an application are the following:

1. [Medical Journal format](#)
2. [Hyperlinked format](#)

We prefer Format 1, because it gives the most complete record of your medical rescue history and allows the moderators to easily identify which threads are confirmed rescues. A good looking app allows us to process it faster. Save and upload the document to OneDrive or Google Docs if the file was created on your computer. Also, make sure that the **share option is set to public**.

Note: We will not accept messy or illegible applications. We will ask you to resubmit it properly.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION

Once you submit your application, please allow **48 hours** for the application to be processed. **Do not** contact us before those 48 hours are up. To submit a request, send an e-mail to RedditRescueForce@gmail.com with the subject line: **RRF Trusted Status Application**. Paste the link to the document from Google Docs (or equivalent), or provide us with the links to the rescues on the message directly. Once a decision is made, you will be contacted immediately.

TRUSTED MEDIC TIER SYSTEM

Even after you become an RRF Trusted Medic, you will have the opportunity to advance your prestige as a trusted medic. The RRF recognizes three tiers of service:

[TIER 1 - Red]	Trusted Medic I	Requirement: (15+ rescues)
[TIER 2 - Purple]	Trusted Medic II	Requirement: (40+ rescues)
[TIER 3 - Gold]	Trusted Medic III	Requirement: (75+ rescues)

Users that achieve any tier must wait one week before applying for the next tier.

When you have enough rescues to advance to the next tier, please send us your rescue history log (same exact format as your RRF Trusted Medic application). We will process your application and make the appropriate changes to your flair. These flairs are for prestige, not for greater privilege.

All Trusted Medics may request that their Teamspeak name be added to their user flair.

FINAL WORDS

There is no guarantee of becoming an RRF Trusted Medic after submitting your file for review. Please make sure that you have fulfilled all necessary requirements for the application. Incomplete applications **will be rejected** without consideration.
