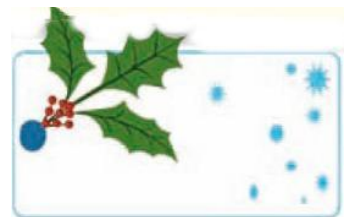

Butter	250 gr
Cognac	1 glass
Eggs	6
Sugar	2 tea cups
Milk	1 cup
Baking Powder	1 teaspoon
other 1	cinnamon
other 2	Vanilla extract
other 3	Orange peel
