

Legacyligan Stockholm Fall Season 2026

Welcome to Legacyligan Stockholm!

Legacyligan Stockholm is a friendly competitive Legacy league with two seasons per calendar year. This post contains general information on how the league is structured. General information

The 19th season of the Stockholm Legacy League will kick off on **Thursday September 3rd** and run for **16 weeks** through **January 21st**. The league will take a break for Swedish Nationals (October 29th) and Eternal Weekend (December 3rd), as well as three weeks over the holidays between December 24th and January 7th. Out of these 16 events, each player's **8** best results will count towards their league score. We will also host competitive Legacy challenges on two weekends over the course of the season. By placing well in these events you will acquire bonus points that count towards your league score that should help you qualify for the league finals.

The **16 highest** ranking players by the end of the season are qualified for the *league finals*. The finals event will take place during a weekend shortly after the end of the season. If one or more of the top ranking players are unable to attend the finals, passdowns are in effect to the next person in the standings.

Weekly events

Each **Thursday** we'll play a Legacy constructed event at **Alphaspel** (Subway station: *Örnsberg*). The events cost **50 kr** to join and registration closes at **18:30**. Out of the entrance fee, a small amount goes back to the store for letting us play in their lovely premises. The rest is divided between prices for the event and a price pool for the league finals. These events will be 4 rounds of Swiss run at regular REL with price returns if you finish 3-1 or better.

Match results are counted towards the league score as follows:

- Each match victory is awarded 3 points
- Each match ending in a draw awards 1 point

For example:

- a **4-0** result would yield **12 points**,
- **3-1** would yield **9 points**, and
- **2-1-1** would yield **7 points**

Out of the 16 events throughout the season, only your 8 *best results* will count towards your league score.

Legacy challenges

We will host two competitive weekend events this season. These events will have a dedicated price pool, and the Top-8 finishers will acquire bonus points that count towards their league score.

The first of these events will take place on **Saturday October 10th**. The second is being planned later in *November*, announcement to come.

The bonus points provided to the Top-8 are distributed as follows:

- **1st place:** 10 bonus points
- **2nd place:** 6 bonus points
- **3rd - 4th place:** 4 bonus points
- **5th - 8th place:** 2 bonus points

Participation bonus

For each weekly event you attend *beyond* the 8th, you will get awarded an additional bonus point, up to a **maximum of 8 points**. Meaning, that if you attend a total of 9 events throughout the season, you will get *one* additional bonus point. If you attend 12 events, you will get four points, and so on. If you partake in all 16 weekly events, you will get a total of 8 bonus points.

League finals

The league finals event will be played on a Sunday after the end of the season. Competitive rules enforcement applies. A registered decklist is required. The event will have a small entrance fee to cover the costs of having a judge and our choice of venue. By popular interest, this entrance fee could be increased to support a larger price pool.

For the finals, we want to make every qualifying position in the Top-16 to matter. To achieve this, the finals will be split into two parts, first one smaller portion of the event where the play/draw is decided by your league standing. This will then be followed by a couple of regular Swiss rounds and a cut to a single-elimination bracket with prizes. The winner of this event will also have their name engraved as the winner of the season on our rotating trophy.

Tiebreakers

If two or more players have the exact same league score by the end of the season the following tiebreakers are in effect:

- Most weekly results of 12 points
- Most weekly results of 10 points
- Most weekly results of 9 points
- Regular competitive event tiebreakers such as match win percentages

If the above somehow still does not resolve a tie, there will be a playoff match between the contestants.
