Creating the FSA ID for FAFSA 2024-2025 (Seniors Only):

- Senior families will be completing the 2024-2025 FAFSA this school year (graduation requirement). At this moment, the FAFSA is scheduled to be released in December by the federal government. In the meantime, families can create their FSA ID accounts. Regardless if the student and/or family member has a Social Security Number. - Students, their spouses, and parents should sign up for an FSA ID at least five days
 prior to the event to ensure full access as your FSA ID must be verified by the Social

 create your FSA ID.

What will I need to bring to fill out the FAFSA?

- FSA ID
- Social Security Number
- 2022 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
- Records of untaxed income
- Records of child support received
- Net worth of investments, businesses, and farms
- Current balances of cash, savings, and checking accounts
